Entries

Entries must be completed according to the FIS Rules and deadlines. (Men's Continental Cup & ICR).

PLEASE SUBMIT DETAILED ENTRIES AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. ACCOMMODATIONS WILL BE ASSIGNED BASED ON DETAILED ENTRIES. (Please see below for two accommodations locations.)

Visas

To check if your nation requires a visa for entry to the United States, please visit the Department of State website. Contact events@orda.org to request a visa letter from the Organizing Committee.

Be aware that to enter in the United States (also via Canada) must follow the ESTA / ETA regulation. Start the process in due time. Please refer to the following websites <https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/>.

ArriveCAN

If you are arriving in Canada, this app can be used on your mobile device prior to arriving in Canada to upload your customs declarations and other required documents. This will help to have a faster customs experience.

Transportation

Each nation is responsible for making their own flight and transportation arrangements. The recommended airports are Montréal-Pierre Elliott Trudeau International Airport (YUL) for international arrival, or Albany International Airport (ALB) for domestic arrival.

Teams are required to book a rental car at the appropriate airport for transportation to Lake Placid. The Organizing Committee will provide teams \$250 to assist with the cost of the rental vehicles.

Finance and Team Quotas

Please note that teams can review their quota and finance paperwork in the Race Office on Saturday October 7th, 2023, from 13:00-17:00 Teams will also be emailed this information to the contact provided on their FIS entries.

Paid Training

Paid training will cost \$35/athlete/day and will be available Wednesday, October 4th from 13:00am- 16:00pm and October 5th from 9:30-12:30. The fee covers training at the Olympic Jumping Complex. Teams are required to pay their training fees before the Team Captain's Meeting on Thursday evening. There will be no paid training offered after Sunday. Training can be paid in the Intervales Lodge



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Accommodations

There will be room blocks set aside for teams near the Olympic Ski Jumping complex in Lake Placid according to the ICR and COC Rules. **Team will be assigned to either the US Olympic and Paralympic Training Center or the High Peaks Resort in Lake Placid, NY. Assignment of accommodations is based on USOPTC Rules and Regulations. Assignment of rooms will be communicated to teams ONLY WHEN DETAILED ENTRIES are submitted. All Athletes and Coaches will receive their meals at the USOPTC daily regardless of their accommodation's assignments. All athletes and coaches will be required to watch the USOPTC SafeSport Video upon entering the facility for check-in or meals. This video will be shown in the Adirondack Room at the USOPTC.** Teams who exceed the quota for athletes/staff will receive an invoice that accounts for the portion of lodging costs not covered by the Organizing Committee, per FIS Continental Cup regulations. These invoices can be received during open finance hours in the Race Office located in the Staging Building. ADDRESSES FOR ACCOMMODATIONS CAN BE FOUND BELOW.

Meals

The LOC will provide all meals in accordance with FIS COC and ICR Rules.

All Athletes and Coaches will receive their meals at the USOPTC daily regardless of their accommodation's assignments. All athletes and coaches will be required to watch the USOPTC SafeSport Video upon entering the facility for check-in or meals. This video will be shown in the Adirondack Room at the USOPTC.

Wax Cabins and Trailers

The Olympic Jumping Complex will have changing cabins for Men and Women and a shared waxing room for ski preparation. Cabins are in the Athlete Warm-up Area. Keys will be picked up from the Race office available from Wednesday, October 4 to Sunday, October 8th and will require a \$50 cash deposit. As part of the \$50 deposit, one transformer converter per team will also be available in the Race Office. Failure to return keys or transformer converters will result in the LOC retaining the deposit.

Coach Check-in and Accreditation

Team leaders should report to the RACE OFFICE- 2nd Floor of Staging Building at the top of The Olympic Jumping Complex, Wednesday between 12:00 and 16:00 or Thursday between 9:00 and 12:30 for check-in, accreditation, and payment of training. Team check-in must be completed before Official Training begins.
