The 2024 Denver Sports Lab FIS Masters Cup and U.S. Ski & Snowboard Masters Western Regional Championships will be held in the Rocky Division at Beaver Creek, CO. The event will include 2SG, 2 one-run GS and SL races all held on the Bear Trap trail accessed by the Centennial Express Lift in the base area.

North American Race Fee Payment:

USA and CAN racers can register online for training and races starting December 1 at: masters.adminskiracing.com, select "National" as your race series if your division is not listed, enter your credit card information, and sign up online. Races are listed in the Rocky Mountain Masters race series.

Credit cards will be charged on February 20th.

International Race Fee Payment:

International racers with USA or CAN credit card should also create an account at masters.adminskiracing.com, select "National" as your race series, enter your credit card information, and sign up online. Races are listed in the Rocky Mountain Masters race series. Credit cards will be charged on February 20th. **The online payment processor cannot process credit cards from outside North America. Payments for international entries can be made onsite at Race City through the Beaver Creek race department (you can also buy your lift tickets at the same time)- credit card preferred.**

RACE FEES (does not include lift ticket - see lift prices below)

\$25 (€20) per race (5 races total \$125 for all races (€100)).

LIFT TICKETS

- Beaver Creek is on the Epic Pass.
- For non-passholders, lift tickets are available for both training and race days February 22-25. You can purchase the discounted tickets at Race City, the building next to the bottom of the Centennial lift and by the bag storage.

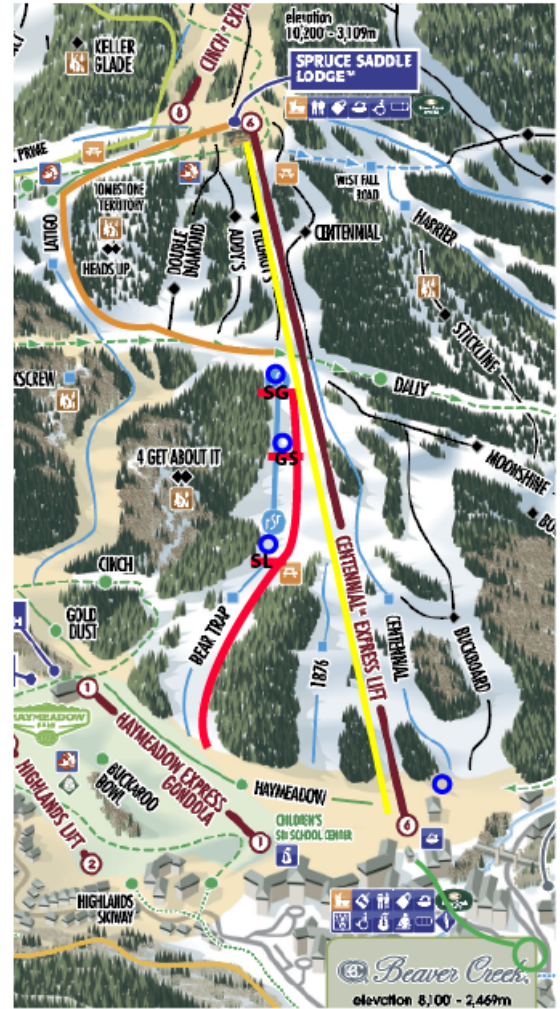

ELIGIBILITY

- FIS Masters Cup races are open to men and women age 30 and older as of December 31, 2023 with a current FIS Masters license and an ACTIVE FIS Masters Code. US competitors must have a current U.S. Ski & Snowboard masters membership as well as a current FIS masters license and an ACTIVE FIS Masters Code.
- US masters under age 30 with a current U.S. Ski & Snowboard masters membership may compete in the US Western Region Championship but are not eligible for FIS Masters awards.
- US masters and Canadians with a current U.S. Ski & Snowboard Alpine Master Membership are eligible for Western Regional Championship Awards.
- USA competitors can purchase a FIS Masters License when renewing your U.S. Ski & Snowboard Membership at my.usskiandsnowboard.org. If you have already renewed you can [add a FIS Masters License](#).

If you have FIS Masters points, you MUST renew by January 26th to be on the current points list! If you renew after that date, you will not have points for start list seeding and will be placed in the unseeded group at the end of your age class.

HELMETS

It is REQUIRED that Masters use helmets that meet the FIS standards for FIS Masters GS, SG , and SL competitions which have a stamp affixed by the manufacturer that states “Conforms to FIS Specification RH 2013”.



RACER CHECK-IN/HEADQUARTERS

All race documents (start lists, referee reports, results, etc) will be delivered via WhatsApp and nightly in an email.

Check-in and bib pickup:

- For morning pickup Feb 22-25 go to Race City lookers right of the Centennial Lift from 7:45-8:15 AM. You will purchase lift tickets at this time also.
- Evening bib pickup is also available 4-6PM on February 22nd before the first TCM meeting at the Comfort Inn.

TEAM CAPTAINS MEETINGS (TCM)

Team Captains Meetings will be held at 6PM on Thursday after check-in at the Comfort Inn meeting room and the EagleVail Pavillion Friday and Saturday before the awards ceremony. MORNING BOOTUP SPACE at the POWDER 8 sponsored by Phillips 66

The Beaver Creek Race Department has arranged for racers to be able to put on boots and gear up in the morning at the Powder 8 Lodge at the base of the Centennial lift. BAGS CANNOT BE LEFT IN THE LODGE. See section below for bag storage locations.

BAG STORAGE

The best places to keep gear during the race day will be at the start or in the fenced area above the building next to the Centennial lift. No bags are allowed to be stored in the lodge. Most parking lots require a shuttle to the base area.

AIRPORT SHUTTLE/RENTAL CARS

Most rental car companies are available at the Denver International Airport.

[Mountain Shuttle Services](#) are available. Colorado Mountain Express, Epic Mountain Express, and Peak 1 Express are the most commonly used.

SPECTATORS

For spectators on foot, you can take the Haymeadow Express Gondola (no lift ticket required) from the base area, cross the Haymeadow trail, and walk down along the trees to the bear trap race finish. Please look uphill while crossing the trail and stay outside the finish fencing for your safety. Can be done in snow boots but yak-tracks or micro-spikes are helpful if you have them.
