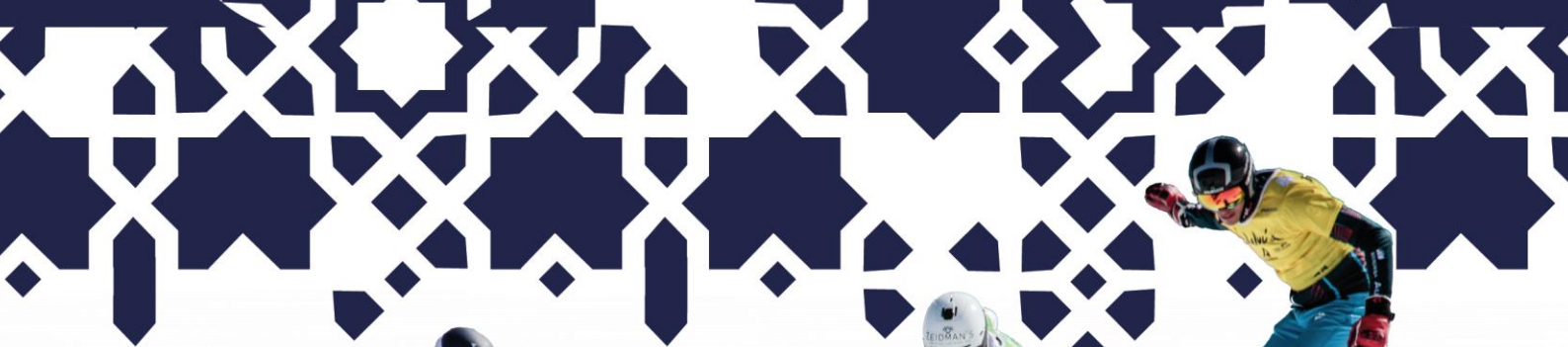

## **FIS SNOWBOARD WORLD CUP 2024 SIERRA NEVADA**

**FEBRUARY 27 - MARCH 04, 2024**

### **1. ENTRIES**

Entries will be accepted from **National Associations** following **FIS** quotas and rules. Please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants by **January 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024**, as per rule 4.2 in the Rules for the **FIS Snowboard World Cup**.

The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than the **February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2024**, as per rule 4.2.1 in the Rules for the **FIS Snowboard World Cup**.

Access to the online registration system is through **FIS** homepage <http://www.fis-ski.com>, then go to **Members Section**. **FIS** has established nation quotas for **World Cups**. **National Snowboard** teams can only enter **World Cup** competitors according to the quota limitations.

### **2. REGISTRATION/RACE OFFICE**

Team's accreditation will take place daily starting on **Tuesday February 27<sup>th</sup>** from **09:00 to 20:00**, at the **Race Office**. The race office is located at: **CETURSA SIERRA NEVADA** building, **Plaza Andalucía 4**, **Sierra Nevada**.

### **3. TEAM CAPTAINS MEETING**

The **Team Captains** meeting will be held in **Sierra Nevada Village** (**Telecabina Cinema**), near the race office. Please see the schedule for meeting times. **First TC Meeting** will be on **Tue 27 of February** at **18:00**.



## 4. ACCOMMODATION

Teams will be hosted for lodging and meals at different partner hotels as per the FIS Snowboard World Cup Rules, from Wednesday February 28th up to Monday 04th. Earlier arrivals or later departures than the official arriving/departure day do not guarantee the FIS rate.

- Official arrival day: Tuesday 27 February 2024

- Official departure day: Monday 04 March 2024

As per the FIS Snowboard World Cup Rule on accommodation and half pension, all competitors and team officials will pay the Euro equivalent of 80 Swiss Francs per day. Each Team Captain has to pay for his/her team's accommodation expenses by credit card. No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the competitors. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay. The payment of the Accommodation must be done directly to the OC - accommodation, before arrivals by credit card or by bank transfer.

Cancellation until 10 days before the first competition day are free of charge. Cancellation within 10 days or less before the first competition day can be charged individually by the hotel.

## 5. LUNCH TICKETS

Sierra Nevada will offer lunch tickets at a special price to all the teams and participants. These tickets will be available at the Race Office.

## 6. PARTICIPATION FEE

According to the FIS Snowboard World Cup Rules, a mandatory participation fee will be charged. This fee consists of CHF 30 per official training, qualification, and competition day for SBX. Total costs per competitor will be CHF 120.

The participation fee has to be paid at the race office before each competition by credit card.



## 7. SKI RESORT LOCATION

### How to get to Sierra Nevada

The Sierra Nevada mountains are located to the southeast of Granada. Granada Airport is the most convenient option, followed by Malaga. From Madrid or Barcelona airports it would be necessary to take a connecting flight down to Granada. The city of Granada is well-connected by rail with high speed lines from Madrid taking around 3 hours and Barcelona taking around 6.5 hours. There are also direct services to Cordoba, Málaga and Sevilla. Granada is also well-connected by motorway with Madrid, Sevilla, Málaga, etc. Additionally, the road Granada-Sierra Nevada takes 40 minutes from Granada downtown.

## 9. LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members or representatives of National Associations will attend the event at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, resort corporation, FIS, RFEDI, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event. All participants must be sufficiently insured against accidents and illness by themselves or their National Association. In addition, the aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.

## 10. ACCIDENT INSURANCE

All competitors participating in FIS events must in accordance with ICR Art. 212 carry an accident insurance, in amount enough to cover accident, transport and rescue costs. The National Associations are responsible for adequate insurance coverage of all their competitors.

The National Ski Associations or their competitors must be able to show proof of the respective insurance coverage at any time on request of FIS, one of its representatives or the Organizing Committee.

Each competitor must have her/his own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee of Sierra Nevada as well as the sponsors, suppliers, their agents and the FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second and third party claims during the event.



All athletes must have previously signed the “FIS Athletes Declaration” form in order to register.

## **11. ACCIDENT PROTOCOL**

In the case of accidents on courses during the event, the medical personnel from the **Organizing Committee** and the Ski Patrol personnel will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital in cooperation with the National Associations medical personnel identified on the entry form.

## **12. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL**

Anti-Doping control testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

## **13. FINANCIAL INFORMATION**

### **PRIZE MONEY**

According to the Spanish law, the income tax retention rate for any sport performance payments must be 19% for residents in the European Union, and 24% for non-residents in the European Union.

Prize money will be CHF 30'000 per gender, per race. In order to process the money transfers accordingly, we ask you to review and doublecheck the bank account information for each athlete in the **FIS Member Section**.
