GENERAL INFORMATION

Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Ski and Snowboard Associations following FIS World Cup quotas and rules. Please submit the provisional entry with anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) by 4th December 2023. The final entry with number of your competition team and names of participants (including competitors and official) must be submitted to the organizers no later than 3rd January 2024.

Registration

The FIS online registration system is accessed through the FIS Homepage “Members Section” <http://www.fis-ski.com>
FIS has established nation quotas for World Cup events. National Snowboard Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the quota limitations. The quotas can be downloaded here: [FIS World Cup Quotas](#)

Onsite registration / Accreditation

Registration and accreditation will be held at the accreditation office in the Seminar Room of the Hotel Belvedere, Stradun 330 in Scuol. Please see the schedule for registration times. All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the accreditation office for check-in before proceeding to the competition venues. All fees will be collected upon check-in.

Athlete Participation Fee: CHF 30.00 per competitor, only cash and credit cards can be accepted at accreditation office.

Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during competition and at the awards ceremony.

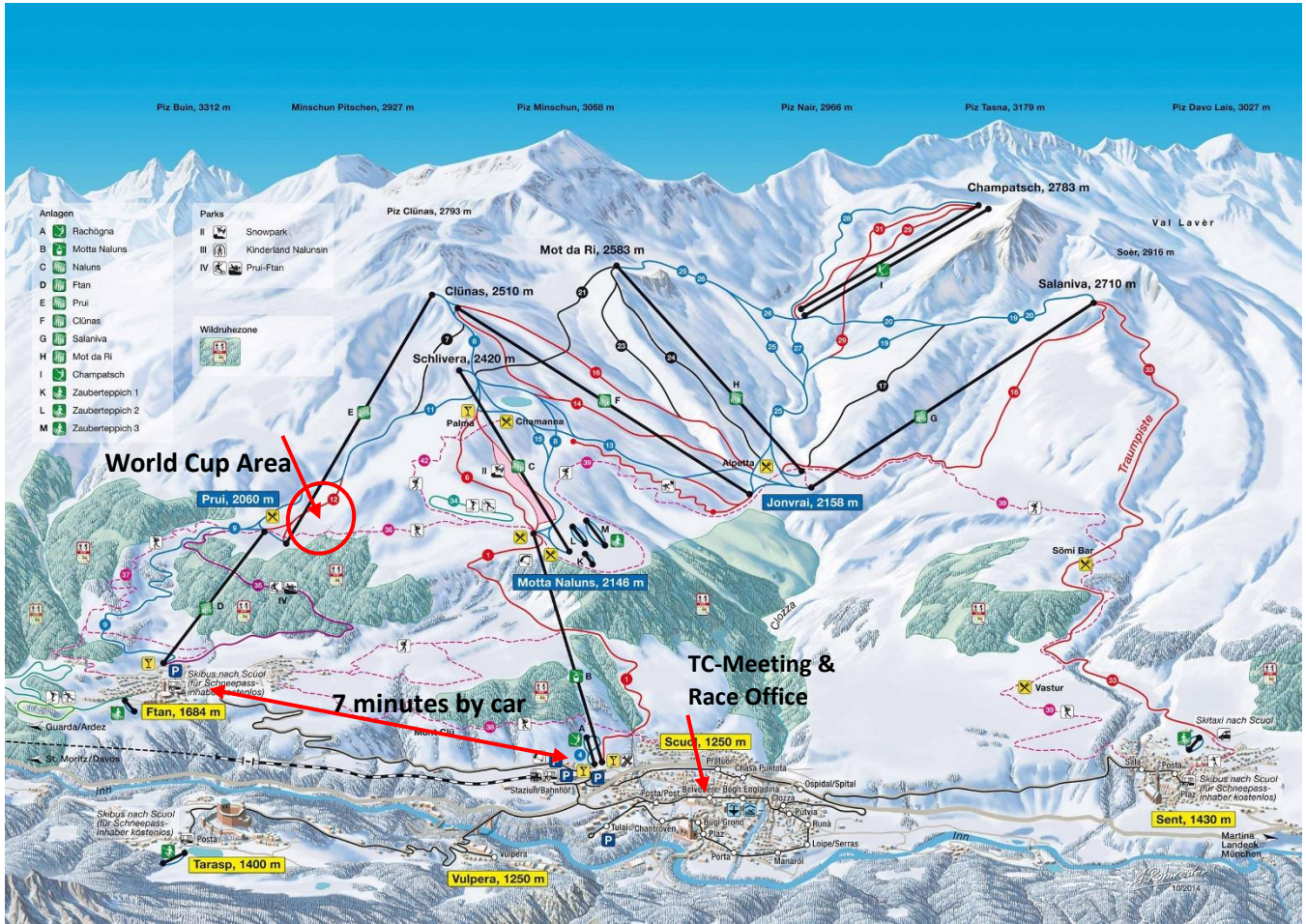
