Rules

- FIS Snowboard, Freestyle and Freeski World Championships St. Moritz Engadin 2025 and Swiss Ski are organizing a FIS Europa Cup competition, part of the 2023-2024 FIS Europa Cup Tour.
- The dates for this competition have been published in the FIS Events Calendar.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations for snowboarding.
- The competition is comprised of ONE (1) PGS and ONE (1) PSL event, for both women and men.
- The competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants.
- The OC and Swiss Ski, subject to the approval of FIS before the start of the competition and subject to the approval of the jury at the moment of the competition, reserve the right to change the schedule of the events from those published in the program, if necessary.

Entries, Quotas and Important Forms

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) by **February 5, 2024,** through the online registration system, accessed through the FIS Homepage Member Section.

The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of the participants must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than **March 11, 2024 at 7 a.m. CET.**

FIS has established Nation Quotas for the Continental Cup Tour. National Ski Associations can only enter the competitors according to the Quota limitations <u>Snowboard Documents</u> (fis-ski.com).

Registration/Ski pass

Team Registration will take place at Hotel Laudinella (Via Tegiatscha 17, CH-7500 St. Moritz) on **Thursday, March 14, 2024 from 12pm to 8pm**. Every athlete and team official is responsible to have the ski pass with him/her at any time during training and competition. All fees have to be paid upon arrival day by credit card.

The race office at Hotel Laudinella will be open daily. Limited hours before the TCM and during the day the race office will be at your disposal at the finish house Salastrains. You will receive onsite information on the arrival day.

Team Captain's Meeting

The Team Captain's Meeting (physical) at Hotel Laudinella are scheduled as follows:

- Thursday, March 14, 2024 8pm to 9pm (informal meeting)
- Friday, March 15, 2024 6pm to 7pm (official meeting)
- Saturday, March 16, 2024 right after competition at the finish house Salastrains

Accommodation, Food, Transportation

Accommodation (half-board, max. 2 people per room/2 beds) and transportation on site will be charged at a maximum of **80 CHF** per day per person (FIS Rate) to all competitors and team officials. Participation Fee (competitors only) of a maximum of **50 CHF** per official training and competition day will be charged to all entered competitors, based on the program in the official invitation.

The number of competitors per country may not exceed the total quota. Accommodation will be provided for 3 nights, as follows:

- Arrival on Thursday, March 14, 2024
- Departure on Sunday, March 17, 2024

Important:

- Team Captains will pay the FIS Rate for the accommodation, starting fee and meal program upon arrival at the Hotel Laudinella in St. Moritz.
- Teams must confirm entries by name and rooming lists for accommodation no later than March 11, 2024 at 7 a.m. CET.
- Last minute cancellations or changes to the confirmed rooming list will not be tolerated. At registration, Team Captains will be charged in full (100%) for the dates and number of athletes and officials submitted on the official entry from / team size form as of **March 11, 2024**. Teams or persons who register late have no right for the reservation or the guarantee of the rate in rule EC 1.4.
- Full payment for each team member of 80 CHF per day (for meal program and accommodation) is required at the registration. All additional charges to the rooms are the responsibility of the Team Captain. No additional charges will be made to or accepted by the OC.
- At the check-in at the hotel each National Association (Team) will be held responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

Meals

Breakfast and dinner will be provided, as follows:

- Beginning with dinner on Thursday, March 14, 2024 and concluding with breakfast on Sunday, March 17, 2024.
- All meals will be served at the hotel.

Lunch at Finish Area Salastrains

We will serve a healthy daily changing lunch at the finish house Salastrains for a reasonable price of 20 CHF per athlete and team official. The offer includes a small starter (soup and/or salad), main course, a small dessert and beverages on the table. Vegetarian plates are available. Please notify us about any allergies in advance, so we can see what we can do for you. We kindly ask you to inform us until **March 11, 2024** about the amount of athletes and

coaches (per day) you would like to buy lunch meals for. You will be given a lunch vouchers per reserved day. We kindly ask you to pay all ordered lunches on the arrival day at the registration office (Hotel Laudinella). Credit card only.

Ground Transportation

Teams are responsible for looking after their own ground transportation. The OC does not provide shuttle services. At the bottom of the gondola Signalbahn will be free parking for teams. One (1) parking permit at the finish area Salastrains close to the finish house Salastrains will be handed out to each nation upon arrival at hotel Laudinella.

Chairlift Salastrains, daily from 8am till 4pm

The valley slope ends at bottom station of the Signal Gondola, right at the parking slots.

Training slope (Giamba Run)

The OC is allowing all participants to train on Friday, March 15, 2024 on the Racehill. There will be two lines of PGS, set by coaches and the training sessions will be open from 8am to 12am. Coordination by Swiss Ski Coach.

The OC reserved training lines on "Giamba Run". On March 13, 2024 (Lines 1+2+3) and on March 14, 2024 (all 4 lines) each from 8am to 4pm. Please read attached rules carefully. The trainings throughout the day have to be organized by the teams directly. Coordination by Swiss Ski Coach. The ski pass can be purchased directly at the bottom station of Signalbahn, St. Moritz-Bad. For the official training and competition days the ski passes will be paid through the OC. The ski passes for training days before the official arrival day have to be paid by the teams.

High Altitude Training Center St. Moritz

St. Moritz is the official Swiss Olympic «High Altitude Training Base». At 1,856 meters above sea level, the center is located at an ideal altitude for training. St. Moritz offers free training possibilities to elite athletes. Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during official training, competition, and award ceremonies.

Liability

All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.

Winner Present

1st to 3rd place winners per gender per event will receive non-cash prize. There will be winner presents, handed out by LOC.

Accident Insurance

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The OC, Sponsors, Suppliers, Swiss Ski, FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second- and third-party claims during the event.

Accident Protocol

In the case of accidents on course during the event, medical personnel from the OC and Ski Patrol staff will be responsible for any medical decisions or evacuation to the local hospital in co-operation with the National Sport Associations' medical staff identified on the entry form.

Anti-Doping Control

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each gender.

Ski Storage / Wax Cabin

The competitors, coaches and officials must store their skis and grooming equipment, as well as wax their skis in the area provided by their respective hotel. Skis will not be allowed in your hotel room.
