Eligibility

Participation is open to all National Sports Associations (NSA) affiliated to FIS.

The competitor must have a valid FIS license.

A maximum of 6 women and 6 men may start per event, per nation.

The FIS Park & Pipe Junior World Championships 2024 are part of the 2023/24 season and age requirements (based on year of birth).

Freeski & Snowboard HP/BA/SS Year of birth:

2006 - 2010

Anti-Doping

Anti-doping control may be conducted during the event.

Medical Plan

The medical plan will be reviewed at the first Team Captain's meeting.

In case of accidents during the events, medical staff, ski patrol and Croce Rossa

Italiana will be in charge of any medical decisions or evacuation to a hospital.

Entries for the FIS Park and Pipe Junior World Championships 2024 will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. All entries must be submitted by the athlete's National Sports Association through the FIS Online Registration and Entry System at www.fis-ski.com

Daily fee including Day Pass for athletes

€40 (approx. CHF 37)

Deadlines for Entries

Preliminarily Entries: February 22nd 2024

Final Entries: March 12th 2024

Competitor Bibs

Training and competition bibs will be allocated at the first Team Captain's Meeting. It is mandatory for all competitors to wear their bibs when training and competing.

Competitor Day Passes

Discounted competitor day passes will be available for official training and competition days. These can be purchased at the Team Captain's Meetings. The number of complimentary passes for team officials and support crew will be relative to the team size.

6.MOTTOLINO FUN MOUNTAIN INFO

Competition Venue Mottolino

Mottolino Fun mountain and Livigno will host the 2024 FIS Park & Pipe Junior World Championships Freeski & Snowboard events for Slopestyle and Big Air. Mottolino Fun Mountain is an internationally recognized world class venue for events. Mottolino Snowpark has a long history of events including multiple editions of "The Nine Knights", "River Jump", "Burton European Open", "World Rookie Tour" and "Europa Cup".

Multi-Day & Season Passes

Outside of the official event days, athletes will need to purchase lift passes directly at the ticket office at Mottolino's HQ. We recommend booking early and checking out our website to see the best lift pass option for you. Getting to the Snowpark

The snowpark is accessible from both towns Livigno and Trepalle, the faster route from Livigno is by parking at the bottom of the main gondola (3), once at the top of the gondola riders and staff can either ski down to the Trepalle lift (8) or take the drag lift (6) and arrive directly at the top of the snowpark. The snowpark is served by the Trepalle Chairlift (8). The main access to the snowpark from Trepalle the lift to take is the Trepalle Chairlift (8).









7.ATHLETE WELCOME, CEREMONIES & AWARDS

Athlete Welcome and Opening Ceremony

Mottolino Fun Mountain and Livigno welcome all athletes, officials and staff to the 2024 FIS Freestyle Ski & Snowboard Junior World Championships. To kick off the events we invite you all to the Opening Ceremony which will take place in Piazza del Comune in Livigno on Friday March 22nd 2024. Please arrive in your team uniform with your country's flag at 17:45. The parade will make its way to the center of the town square where the official opening ceremony and athlete welcome will be held. More details to follow.

Awards Ceremonies

The Flower Ceremonies will take place on the mountain at the end of each Final's Day.

The Awards Ceremonies will take place in Piazza del Comune at a time to be defined after each Finals Day.

The top 6 placing athletes are required to attend these ceremonies and should be available for media interviews immediatly after the awards ceremonies.

Airports

The closest Airports to Livigno are

Bolzano/Bozen (BZO) - 2 and a half hours by car

Milan Bergamo (BGY) - 3 hours and 45 minutes by car

Milan Linate (LIN) - 3 hours and 45 minutes by car

Milano Malpensa (MXP) - 4 hours by car

Zurich (ZRH) - 3 and a half hours by car

Cars and buses

Livigno boarders with Switzerland and can be accessed via two different routes, from Switzerland (Tunnel Munt La Schera) or from Italy (Passo del Foscagno).

The road from Switzerland to Livigno is open h24 from Sunday to Friday whereas on Saturday the tunnel has a fixed schedule: 0:00 - 06:00 alternating one-way traffic, 06:00 - 09-00* traffic in direction Switzerland, 10:00 - 18:00 traffic in direction Italy/Livigno, 18:00 - 00:00 alternating one-way traffic.
