We are delighted to invite you to the FIS World Cup Slopestyle & Halfpipe. We look forward to welcoming the world's best freestyle ski and snowboard athletes back to Aotearoa, New Zealand.

The FIS World Cups will be held at Cardrona Alpine Resort from August 27th - September 9th 2024. The FIS World Cups form part of the wider Winter Games NZ event which returns for its eleventh edition in the beautiful Southern Lakes District of New Zealand.

In addition to the World Cups, there is a FIS ANC Snowboard Halfpipe will be held between August 25th - 28th and the FIS ANC Freeski Slopestyle from September 3rd - 6th.

The full Winter Games NZ 2024 Programme includes two FIS World Cups, two FIS Australia New Zealand Continental Cups, four FIS Australia New Zealand Continental Cups Alpine races (GS & SL) and two FIS Freeride World Tour qualifier events (2* & 4*).

Eligibility

The competitor must have a valid FIS license.

Minimum Standards to Participate in a World Cup:

Snowboard Slopestyle:

120 FIS points or 230 WSPL points

Freeski Halfpipe:

10 FIS points

Thursday September 5th – Monday September 9th 2024

Medical Procedure

For all official training and competition days, there will be dedicated medical staff at the top of the course. Provided by Cardrona Alpine Resort, there will be a minimum of 2 ski patrollers and 1 doctor who can respond on the course if needed.

There is a medical centre up Cardrona that will advise the next step if need be.

Please follow medical staff directions at all times, even if you have your own medical team.

Anti-Doping

Anti-doping control may be conducted during the event.

ENTRY PROCESS & COMPETITOR PASSES

Entry Criteria

Entries will only be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules for slopestyle and HP events. Entries must be submitted to the OC using the FIS online registration system within the mentioned below dates and deadlines and please keep in mind the 60 day deadline (June 30th for Slopestyle and July 9th for Halfpipe) as maximum field sizes will be applied if needed as by W.C rules.

Please read carefully the W.C. quota sheets and procedures.

World Cup quota files will be issued the first days of June the latest.

Please make sure that all athletes have a valid FIS license.

Participation Fees

\$150 NZD (80 CHF) per event.

Payment method will be communicated to confirmed teams.

Competitor Day Passes

Lift day passes will be provided to all competitors and team officials for official training and competition days and will be distributed at the team captain's meetings. The number of complimentary passes for team officials and support crew will be relative to the team size listed below.

Officials & Support Crew

AWARDS & PRIZE MONEY

Awards

Flower ceremonies will take place in the finish area immediately after the final competitor in each competition final.

A medal presentation will follow shortly after in the Cardrona courtyard.

The top 3 placing athletes are required to attend these ceremonies and should be available for media interviews immediately after the awards.

Podium winners must wear their competition bib.

Competitor Bibs

Training and competition bibs will be allocated at the first Team Captain's Meeting. All competitors must wear their assigned bibs when training and competing.

Prize Money

The total amount is 30,000 CHF per gender and event.

This is a total Prize Money amount of 120,000 CHF across all Winter Games NZ FIS World Cup events.

The prize money breakdown is per FIS Rules and payments will be made electronically.

Team Captain's Meeting

A full schedule for each TCM will be sent to confirmed teams along with an information pack prior to your arrival. The first meeting will be the night before the first official training day at the Lake Wānaka Centre - 89 Ardmore St, Wānaka.

Competition Venue

Cardrona Alpine Resort is an internationally recognized venue with world class course builders and shapers.

Big Bucks Terrain Park has had massive infrastructure upgrades in recent years with approximately 7000m³ earth moved to improve chairlift clearance on the higher features, widening and raising all knuckles and steepening all landings.

Please note Cardrona is a non-smoking mountain and does not permit the use of cigarettes and vapes.

Multi-Day & Season Passes

Outside of the official event days, athletes will need to purchase lift passes directly from Cardrona Alpine Resort.

TRAVEL, LOGISTICS & ACCOMODATION

Visas

New Zealand has a special policy for athletes, coaches, administrators, officials and support staff visiting the country to participate in sporting events. Please check with NZ Immigration to find out if visitors from your country require a visitor visa to enter New Zealand. Information and application forms for visitor visas are available on www.immigration.govt.nz or from New Zealand and Australian Consulates, Embassies or High Commissions.

Liability & Insurance

All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Winter Games NZ, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by the athletes, officials or other persons in conjunction with the organising or staging of the event. Public Liability Insurance (CHF) 5 million, for the period of the event, is in place.

If you are injured in New Zealand (including whilst competing in a competition), you may need the assistance of the Accident Compensation Corporation (ACC), New Zealand's accident compensation scheme. ACC helps pay for your care – and that means paying towards the cost of your treatment and helping your recovery while you remain in New Zealand. ACC will not cover any medical or related costs arising from the accident after you leave New Zealand. You will accordingly still need to arrange your own travel and medical insurance. New Zealand's medical facilities are not free to visitors except as a result of an accident but even in the case of an accident, surcharges in private facilities will apply.

Air Travel

We recommend that you book your flights as early as possible and fly into Queenstown.

Air New Zealand, Jetstar, Qantas and Virgin Australia are the only airlines that fly directly into Queenstown. However, many other international airlines fly direct into Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch.

Vehicle Transport

Wānaka & Queenstown – The Beautiful Southern Lakes District

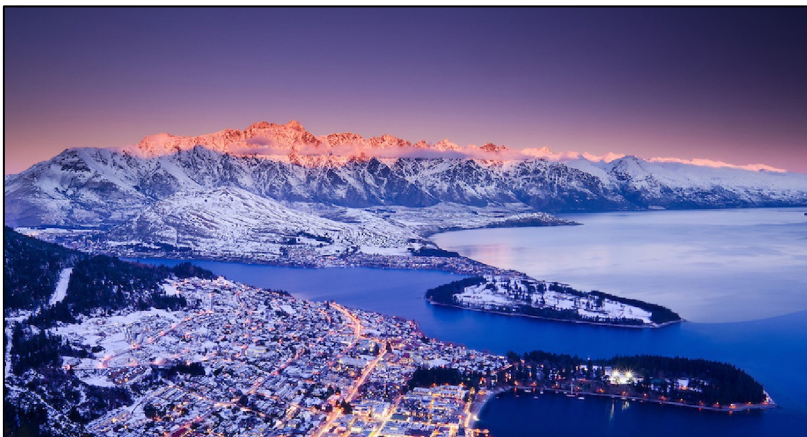
