U.S. Competitors:

Field Size: 160 total competitors, 80 per gender

All Athletes & Coaches must register by **December 1, 2024**.

Foreign Competitors:

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations until November 1, 2024.

Please note:

- Foreign Inscriptions will be considered on a first come first serve basis.
- A maximum of 10 competitors per gender will be accepted for the start.
- If there are more than 10 applicants to start, then athletes will be selected based off of their current FIS point ranking as of November 1, 2024.
- National Teams will be notified of the official event entry by November 4, 2024.
- If any competitor drops, the list will be adjusted as needed to reflect the top 10 competitors per gender.





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Registration Opens: October 1, 2024

Registration Closes: December 1, 2024

Entry Fee: \$325.00

This Entry Fee gives athlete and coach access to training days, qualifying competition, and finals for qualifying athletes.

All competitors must have an event bib and lift pass to have athlete accreditation.

Registered coaches, with competing athletes, will be provided complimentary lift access only. One coach pass per five competing athletes.

Please note, lost lift passes will not be replaced; if lost, new passes for competitors and coaches must be purchased at full price at the ticket window.

Winter Park Competition Center Office will be open until 6pm on the evening of December 10th to assist with competition registration. Additionally, the Competition Center Office will open at 7am on December 11th.

REFUND POLICY: Refunds will only be issued if injury or illness occur prior to first day of competition with a note from a doctor or licensed mental health professional.
