GENERAL INFORMATION

Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Ski and Snowboard Associations following FIS World Cup quotas and rules. Please submit the provisional entry with anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) by 11th November 2024.

The final entry with number of your competition team and names of participants (incl. competitors and officials) must be submitted to the organizers no later than 11th December 2024.

Registration

The FIS online registration system is accessed through the FIS Homepage "Members Section" Click [here](#). FIS has established nation quotas for World Cup events. National snowboard teams can only enter World Cup competitors according to the quota limitations.

Onsite Registration / Accreditation

Registration and accreditation will take place at the race office in the main building of Davos Klosters Mountains (Jakobshorn gondola station), Brämabüelstrasse 11, 7270 Davos Platz. Please see respective registration times.

All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the registration area for check-in before proceeding to the competition venue. All fees will be collected upon check-in.

Athlete Participation Fee: CHF 30.00 per competitor (to be paid in cash or per credit card at race office).
