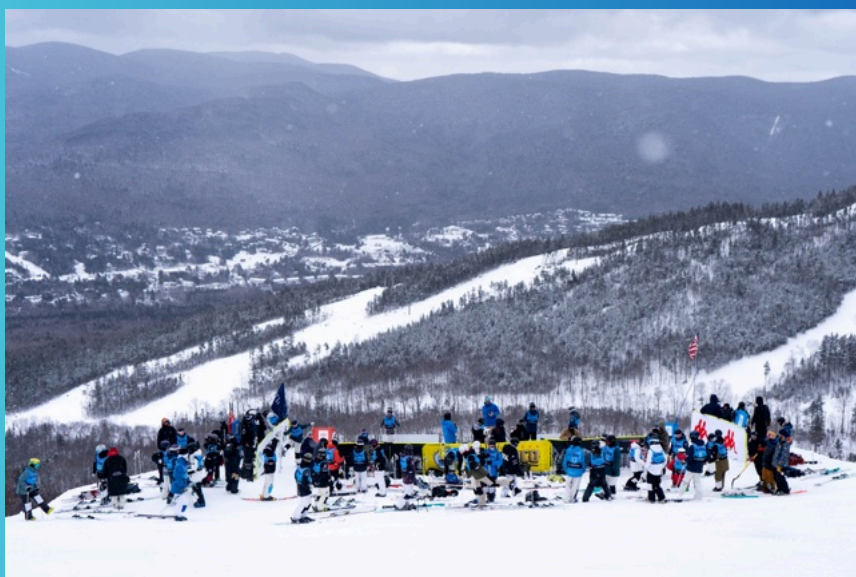

Preliminary Team Entry Deadline: December 15, 2024

- Please include all competitors and officials in preliminary entry

Final Room Configuration and Entries: January 14, 2025

- Please include final number of competitors, officials, and lodging needs

- Note: In accordance with the 2023-2024 FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Rule Book, the Organizing Committee will honor rule 3.2.

Prior to arrival:

1. Designate one Team Leader to must submit all required documentation, waivers, team lodging requests, and athlete accreditation prior to January 13, 2025.
2. Foreign Nationals must have a current passport and a Visa or ESTA to enter the United States.

Team Invoices:

Invoices will be created and sent January 14th, 2025. Payment must be received by January 17th at the latest.

Teams are financially responsible for changes made after January 14th. Any athlete withdraw after this date will be charged to the team.

ALL BANK INFORMATION MUST BE UPLOADED TO THE FIS DATABASE PRIOR TO FINALS. ATHLETES WITHOUT THE CORRECT BANK INFORMATION UPLOADED TO THE FIS SYSTEM WILL EXPERIENCE A DELAY IN PRIZE MONEY BANK TRANSFER.

THE WINNERS WILL RECEIVE PRIZE MONEY VIA BANK TRANSFER ONLY (NO CHECKS). 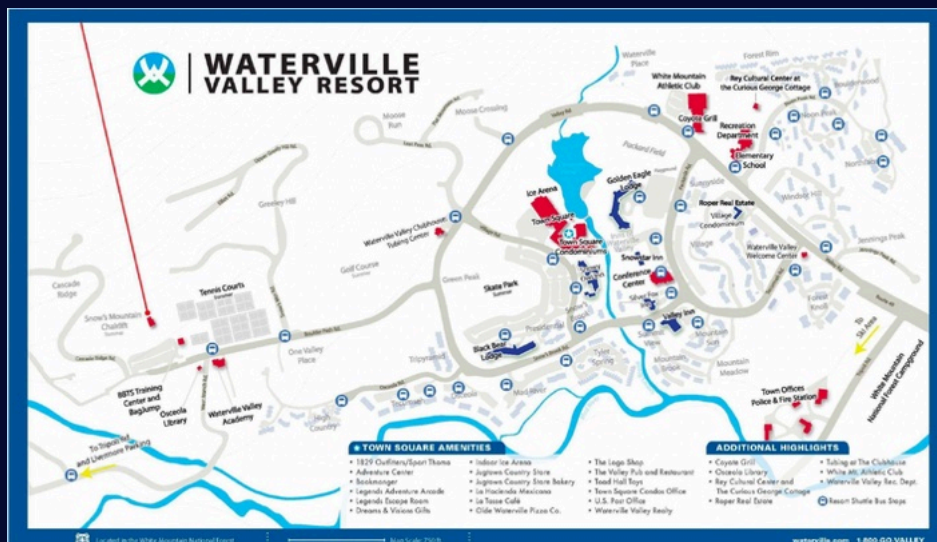
