TEAM INVITATION

On behalf of the Austrian Ski Federation, the Kreischberg and the holiday Region of Murau we are pleased to invite all teams to attend the FIS Freeski & Snowboard Big Air World Cup 2025 at the Kreischberg. The event will be held in accordance with the International Ski and Snowboard Federation (FIS) rules for competitions & World Cup from January 7-11, 2025.

The event starts on Tuesday, January 7, with the first official practice.

Another official training is scheduled for January 8.

Thursday, January 9 is the qualification day for Freeski and Snowboard women.

Friday, January 10 is the qualification day for Freeski men and the Freeski finals for women and men.

Saturday, January 11 is the qualification day for Snowboard men and the Snowboard finals for women and men.

There is no reserve day in case of bad weather.

REGISTRATION

Entries will only be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules for slopestyle events. Entries are open now and must be submitted to the OC using the FIS online registration system within the mentioned deadlines and please keep in mind the 60 days deadline (10 of November) as maximum field sizes will be applied if needed as by W.C rules. Please read carefully the W.C. quota sheets and procedures.

Please make sure that all athletes have a valid FIS license.

The World Cup rules are available on the FIS website.

Provisional entry deadline November 10, 2024.

Final entry deadline December 28 2024.

ACCOMMODATION

Team accommodation, halfboard at CHF 80,- per day per person in doubleroom according to the FIS World Cup rules will be offered for the dates of the official program. Additional officials or accompanying persons and staff will be charged with CHF 110,- per day per person. According to World Cup rule 2.2.1.3.

Please note that accommodation at the FIS rate is available for the dates of the program only.

Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the FIS rate. The rate has to be paid directly to the tourism office. Any extras must be paid by the teams or athletes themselves. A credit card is requested at your arrival at the hotel for deposit. The FIS rate can only be guaranteed for bookings made until November 25, 2024. We have blocked rooms at the official event hotels.

ACCREDITATION

Registration and accreditation will be held at the Kreischberghalle on **January 06. and 07. 2025.**

Please see the official event schedule for registration times. All competition participants (including competitors and officials) must report to the registration office for check-in before proceeding to their accommodations or the competition venue. If you are planning to bring a media team with you or know of someone wishing to cover the event, please note that they must be accredited by the Kreischberg World Cup media office. This applies whether they are editorial media or filming for promotional purposes.

Media accreditation requests prior to the arrival are appreciated.

ENTRY FEES

An administration fee will be charged for each World Cup competitor. All fees will be collected upon check-in at the registration office. We accept debit and credit cards as well as cash. **The administrative fee is CHF 200,- (as per FIS rules) per competitor.**

LIFT TICKETS

Lift tickets will be provided to all competitors and team officials for official training and competition days and will be distributed at the first team captains' meeting.

The number of free lift tickets given out to team officials will be relative to the team's size (as per FIS World Cup rules).

BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during all scheduled official trainings, competition and at the award ceremony. Training and competition bibs will also be allocated at the team captains meetings.

A deposit of € 50,- per bib will be required in cash at the first team captains' meeting.

Anti-doping control testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

TRAINING

The official training days are scheduled for January 07 and 08. For more detailed information on the exact training times, please check the schedule down below. Athletes must have a valid FIS license to compete. Additional training will take place before each heat during competition and quali times on January **09, 10** and **11**.

SANCTIONING

Athletes must have a valid FIS license to compete.

AWARD CEREMONY

Medal ceremonies will take place on the mountain immediately after the competitions' final. Podium placing athletes are obliged to attend these ceremonies and should be available for media interviews and athlete signings immediately after the awards.

ENTERTAINMENT & SIDE EVENTS

For the first time we will work with live music acts during the finals supporting the DJ and MC's. As always we hope to show you an awesome time all around during your stay at Kreischberg.

LUNCH / DINNER DURING TRAINING / COMP DAYS

As you are used to in the meanwhile we'll provide our infamous Catering Service to all of you next to the start with warm drinks and warm food.

PRIZEMONEY
