## Rules

- FIS Snowboard, Freestyle and Freeski World Championships Montafon 2027 and Ski Club Montafon are organizing a FIS Freestyle Ski competition, part of the 2024-2025 Continental Cup of the International Ski Federation (FIS) Tour
- The dates for this competition have been published in the FIS Events Calendar
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations for freestyle skiing.
- The competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants.
- The OC and Ski Austria, subject to the approval of the FIS before the start of the competition and subject to the approval of the jury at the moment of the competition, reserve the right to change the schedule of the events from those published in the program, if necessary.

## Entries, Quotas and Important Forms

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quota and rules. Access to the online registration system is possible through the FIS Homepage <http://www.fis-ski.com/> Member Section.

All quotas and entries are according to the FIS Rules for Continental Cup 2024/25. Only those competitors who are entered by national Associations are eligible and the number of participants is limited under current Continental Cup quotas.



Please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) by **13<sup>th</sup> January 2025**.

The final number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of the participants must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than **12<sup>th</sup> February 2025**. Use the official FIS entry form.

### Registration / Ski Pass

Team Registration will take place at the Montafon Nordic Sportzentrum (Montafon Nordic Sportzentrum | Werkweg 2 | 6774 Tschagguns) starting on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> February 2025 from 5pm to 8pm. All fees and deposits must be paid upon registration. Every athlete and team official is responsible to have the ski pass with him/her at any time during training and competition.

## Meals

Breakfast and dinner will be provided at your hotel. Lunch will be available at the different huts in the ski resort.

## Ground Transportation

Teams are responsible for looking after their own ground transportation. The OC does not provide shuttle services. At the bottom of the gondola Golm there will be free parking for teams. Access to the finish area Grüneck will only be by gondola.

## Bibs

All competitors must wear bibs during official training, competition and award ceremonies.



## Entry Fee

Entry Fees may be charged to a maximum of Swiss Francs 80,- (CHF) per competitor per event and Swiss Francs 40,- (CHF) per competitor per official training day. The ski pass is included.

Payments only with credit card.

## Liability

All athletes, officials and other members of their National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, FIS Snowboard, Freestyle and Freeski World Championships Montafon 2027, Ski Austria and the Ski Club Montafon, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event. All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times. The aforementioned parties will take no responsibility for missing belongings.

## Prize Money

Prize money will be awarded at each FIS Europa Cup competition based on the total number of competitors entered into a Europa Cup event in Aerials and Moguls. The total prize money available for each event will be determined by CHF 10,-- x the total number of competitors starting in each event. Prize Money is calculated separately for each event and the total prize money is split equally between women and men.

An organizer is permitted to award more prize money in excess of the formula. Prize money will be according to the following percentage of the Total Prize Money per event and taking into consideration the local tax laws: 1st place = 50% 2nd place = 30% 3rd place = 20%.



In the case where supplemental prize money is provided the OC is allowed to determine the breakdown of percentages of prize money in excess of the minimum dictated by the rule above. Prize money is paid to the athletes at the end of each competition day.

The amount of prize money will be calculated and announced at the draw before each competition at the TC meeting. The OC must assist the competitors with matters relating to taxation for prize money awarded in the country in which the competition is held.

### **Accident Insurance**

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The OC, Sponsors, Suppliers, Ski Austria, Ski Club Montafon, FIS decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged equipment and second- and third-party claims during the event.

### **Accident Protocol**

In the case of accidents on course during the event, medical personnel from the OC and Ski Patrol staff will be responsible for any medical decisions or evacuation to the local hospital in co-operation with the National Sport Associations' medical staff identified on the entry form.

### **Anti-Doping Control**

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each gender.

### **Ski Storage / Wax Cabin**

The competitors, coaches and officials must store their skis and grooming equipment, as well as wax their skis in the area provided by their respective hotel. Skis will not be allowed in your hotel room.
