LICENSES

All athletes are required to have an **active FIS number**.

Coaches/athletes/officials that represent a Canadian team are required to have a valid FC license and all requirements related to its validation (background check, appropriate training, mandatory NCCP modules).



LIABILITY AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE

All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the maneuvers being performed in training and competition. All athletes, coaches and officials must have a valid membership. The organizing committee, the P/TSO, the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, the resort and the Canadian Snowsports Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second- or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to always protect and safeguard their personal belongings.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Please note that there will be **ZERO TOLERANCE** for any offensive language or behavior during the event. Any damages or disruption to hotel, facilities or other property related to this event will result in the offender(s) being immediately removed from the event.

FIELD SIZE

In accordance with NAC 10.3- Quotas: Each nation is provided an equal number of quota spots for men and women; each nation is expected to provide equal opportunity per gender to fill spots. The quotas for the NorAm Cup Tour for MO/DM events are as follows:

CAN	50 - Maximum of 30 per Gender
USA	50 - Maximum of 30 per Gender
Foreign Nations	30
Maximum Field Size	130

- Top 6 Super finals

Dual Moguls:

- Duals from the start

ACCIDENT PROTOCOL

In the case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol personnel will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the local hospital in cooperation with the National Associations' medical personnel identified on the entry form.

EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

COMPETITION OFFICE

BIBS

- Bibs can be picked up during Competition Office hours.
- Must be worn properly for all on-site training and for the competitions.
- No deposit is required, but Teams will be held responsible if not returned and charged \$45 each.
- Volunteers will collect the bibs at the bottom of the course after Duals.
- It is important that your bib number matches your event registration for judging and scoring.

LIFT TICKETS

Each competitor is responsible for the purchase of his or her own lift ticket for each day of training and competition. Tickets will be available at the ticket booth with presentation of competitor bib. Multi day tickets are available.

- Ticket office will open at 8:00 am daily.
- Athletes daily 33,99\$ + taxes - for 4 days total 135,96\$ + taxes
- MC/Visa accepted for purchase

Complimentary lift tickets for coaching staff, judges, media, officials and volunteers are available at the Competition Office each day but are limited in numbers:

- Up to 1 ticket per 4 athletes registered under the same team
