2. Rules

- Georgian Ski Federation, Mountain Trails Agency, and the organizing committee of the FIS SKI CROSS WORLD CUP are organizing the Ski Cross World Cup on February 26th and March 1st; in Gudauri ski resort.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations of FIS Snowboard / Freestyle / Freeski World Cup Rules.
- This competition is a Ski Cross event and is open to both Men and women.
- This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to change the schedule depending on the snow conditions, weather, or the decision of the competition jury.



3. Entries

Registration/Entries

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules.

All entries must be done using the FIS Online Registration System, through the FIS home page: <http://www.fis-ski.com/> "Member Section". FIS has established national quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations. 4. Registration and Means of Payment

- All teams are responsible for arriving and registering at the race office – located in Hotel “Marco Polo” on the first Team Captain’s meeting, on February 24th.
- Accommodation with Half Board for the dates: February 26th and March 2nd in Gudauri ski resort, is CHF 80 per person per night.
- The LOC will waive the FIS rate for the top 5 men/women as per the current SX WC standing

7. Transfer

- Participants are responsible for their own transportation. Gudauri ski resort is located 144 km away from Tbilisi International Airport, The OC offers transfers between the airport of Tbilisi and the resort (busses, minivans for teams, and trucks for equipment). Transfer requests are to be sent to office trifectasportstours@gmail.com and should include the following information:
 1. Arrival/departure date, time, flight numbers, destination (from/to)
 2. Number of passengers and all names of participants in a group
 3. Amount of luggage in pieces and its approximate total weight.
- Transportation on site will be provided by The OC and will be free of charge.
- The accommodation and transfer request should be sent no later than the 16th of January 2025
- Competitors, coaches, and OC key staff will be accommodated in Hotel “TBA”
- The Team Captains meeting will be held in the Hotel “Marco Polo” conference room. For detailed information please see the attached competition Program.

- a. In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical staff from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the Tbilisi Medical Centre or local hospital.
