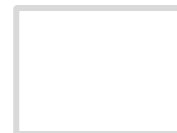

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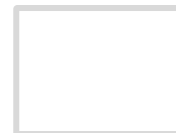
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1. Entries

The FIS Online Registration System must be used to register the participating teams.

Preliminary entry counts as accommodation and wax cabin booking. An extra wax cabin must be ordered using the entry system.

2. Accommodation

The teams are accommodated at the GreenStar Lahti, close to the city centre. Address: Vesijärvenkatu 1, 15100 Lahti.

Teams and SRS companies must use the FIS online booking system by requesting the number of rooms, SGL / DBL with full board, and arrival and departure dates. NSA who are not using the online system and do not respect the deadlines are losing their rights to Continental Cup prices and/or conditions.

The OC will cover accommodation costs according to the reimbursement lists in the rules.

Over-quota payments

- Teams will be directly responsible for over-quota accommodation costs to the OC.
- Over-quota accommodation will be invoiced. Please note that payment cannot be made on-site or at the hotel.
- Please provide your invoice address to accommodation@lahtiskigames.com before the pre-entry deadline.

Cancellation deadlines and fees

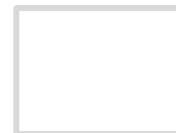
Preliminary entry counts as booking. Teams are responsible for cancelling rooms that are not needed.

The organiser charges the respective National Ski Association a cancellation fee for booked room reservations not used or cancelled in time.

A cancellation fee will be applied using the deadlines from the Ski Jumping COC rules to determine the payment amount. Between 7 days before the Team Captains' meeting and until the end of the events, the OC will charge a cancellation fee of 100% of the total cost.

Teams and SRS companies must use the FIS competition online entry system for accommodation reservations by the following deadlines:

- **Until 14 days before the Team Captains' meeting** Teams and SRS can change their bookings by adapting the preliminary entry.



Cancellation (entire team or only some rooms) is **free of charge for 25% of the rooms booked**.

- **Between 13 until 8 days before the Team Captains' meeting** Teams and SRS have to provide their final entry to the LOC latest 8 days before the Team Captains' meeting of the event. The LOC has the right to charge a cancellation fee with a size tolerance of 10% (**cancellation free of charge for 10% of the rooms booked**).

- **Between 7 days and until the end of the events**(departure date chosen by the team): **A cancellation fee of 100% will be charged**.

3. Team's lunch

The Women's Ski Jumping teams

- Women's teams have lunch on Friday and Sunday at the hotel. The Saturday lunch will be served at the venue after the competition.

The Men's Ski Jumping teams

- Men's teams have lunch at the hotel on Friday and Saturday. The Sunday lunch will be served at the venue after the competition.

Lunch at the venue will be served at the Team Café in the SJ/NC service area from Friday to Sunday, 11:00 to 15:00.

Your accommodation confirmation email will contain information about lunches outside the venue.

4. Accreditation

The teams' accreditation will be handed out at the race office at the ski jumping hill. Address: Suurmäenkatu 5, FI- 15900 Lahti.

FIS officials, judges, and Ewoxx will receive accreditation from the grandstand building at Lahti Sports Centre.

5. Transport

The official airport is Helsinki airport (94 km from Lahti).

The organising committee can arrange transportation between the airport and the hotels. Teams must send the transportation request, exact arrival times, flight numbers, and the number of arriving people to the organiser at the latest eight (8) days before arrival via the FIS Online Entry system. Transportation price: 50€ / person / one-way.

Transportation payments around the Team Captains Meeting by credit card; invoicing or cash payments are not accepted. The office is located on the same floor as TCM.

The departure of booked transports at the airport

The bus station is in front of the airport terminal at the same level as arrivals. Follow the signs marked "charter" after exiting the gate.

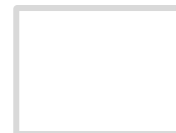

6. Reimbursement

Reimbursement for FIS Officials

Send expense sheets to finance@hiihtoliitto.fi. Payment will be made via bank transfer.

7. Prize money

Contact finance@hiihtoliitto.fi for all prize money questions.

The prize money payment is according to the Continental Cup Rules. OC will use a protected FIS database to collect payment information for prize money. Please ensure all your athletes' data is uploaded to the system before the competition weekend (including Tax codes).

Finnish law does not allow any prize money transfer without indicating the TINs (Tax identification number).

To find your Personal TIN, please follow the instructions provided on this website <https://www.oecd.org/tax/automatic-exchange/crs-implementation-and-assistance/tax-identification-numbers/>.

The income tax is 15% for European and non-European citizens. For US citizens whose fees and expense reimbursements do not exceed \$20,000 per year in Finland, the tax rate is 0%. If athletes request it, the OC will provide a receipt of taxes paid along with the prize money.

Prizegiving ceremonies will follow the competition at the Lahti letter sign by the ski bridge.

8. Team Services

Waxing facilities, Team Areas, offices & training

The Ski Jumping service area is at the ski jumping hills. Waxing facilities are next to the hill.

Athletes' Rooms, Team Café' and the SJ and NC race office are in the buildings below the large hill.

Wax cabins

To access the cabins, you can get the keys from the race office in the team area at the hill. To get the keys, you will need to deposit 100€. Please note that the key must be returned on the day of departure, at the latest, the day after the last competition. Additional wax cabins must be paid by credit card during key pickup.

Please ensure that all garbage is emptied into recycling bins and that the wax cabins are clean. Drilling or screwing into the walls is prohibited in containers.

OC charges €150 for cleaning each dirty wax cabin or for the supplier to repair wall holes. When the keys are handed over, LOC will inspect the wax cabins.
