If you do not race in any of the USA race series, select "National" as your race series. Races are listed in the Intermountain Masters race series. **Credit cards will be charged on February 3rd.** Cash payments can be made when you check-in to pick up your bib.

## LIFT TICKETS

- **[IKON season pass holders](#) must reserve through the reservation system online in advance. The number of IKON passes allowed per day may be limited by the resort so reserve as early as possible. Be sure to know whether you have 5 or 7 days. If you need additional days, purchase a racer ticket for those days. If you scan to board the lift additional days beyond what is covered by your IKON pass and have a credit card attached to your IKON account, it will charge that card full price for the additional day.**
- For non-passholders, order your lift tickets online at the link for both training and race days February 4-9. You can load the tickets onto an existing "Sky Card" or pick an RFID card up at a kiosk in the base area.

## ELIGIBILITY

- FIS Masters Cup races are open to men and women age 30 and older as of December 31, 2024 with a current ACTIVE FIS Masters code. US competitors must have a current U.S. Ski & Snowboard masters membership as well as a current ACTIVE FIS Masters Code.
- US masters under age 30 with a current U.S. Ski & Snowboard masters membership may compete in the US Western Region Championship but are not eligible for FIS Masters awards.
- US masters and Canadians are eligible for Western Regional Championship Awards.
- USA competitors can purchase a FIS Masters License when renewing your U.S. Ski & Snowboard Membership at [uskiandsnowboard.org/tools](http://uskiandsnowboard.org/tools). If you have already renewed your membership, you can use this form to [Add FIS Masters License](#).

\*\*\*If you have FIS Masters points, you MUST renew by January 26th to be on the current points list! If you renew after that date, you will not have points for start list seeding and will be placed in the unseeded group at the end of your age class.\*\*\*

## HELMETS

It is REQUIRED that Masters use helmets that meet the FIS standards.

- For FIS Masters GS and SG competitions which have a stamp affixed by the manufacturer that states "Conforms to FIS Specification RH 2013".
- For SL competition, helmets must be certified under EN 1077 (class B) or ASTM 2040 as minimum standard with soft ear padding allowed. Helmets meeting the higher standards for GS and SG competition may also be used for SL.



## RACER CHECK-IN

Checkin for arriving racers will be at Race Headquarters in the Lake/Canyon Rooms of the Yellowstone Conference Center in the Huntley Lodge. Racer checkin will be open on Thursday from 4pm to 6:30pm with a pause at 5:30 for the TCM. Morning check-in will also be open from 8:00 - 9:00 am on Thursday through Sunday.

## RACE HEADQUARTERS

Race Headquarters will in the Lake/Canyon meeting rooms of the Yellowstone Conference Center in the Huntley Lodge. (lower level of the conference center meeting rooms wing) Racer checkin and information posting boards with schedules, results, and announcements will be located at Race Headquarters, so for questions and current information this is the place to visit!
