Final Application Date: 18.02.2025

PARTICIPATION FEE:

According to the FIS WC rules each competitor must pay a mandatory entry fee of 30 CHF (or the equivalent in EUR or Turkish Lira) to the organizing committee for official training and competition days. The payment must be made in cash to the race office before the competition.

REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION:

Registration and accreditation will take place on February 25, 2025, at the race office located at the Snowdora Hotel in Palandöken

TC MEETINGS:

All scheduled Team Captains' Meetings (TCM) will be held in the meeting room of the Snowdora Hotel in Palandöken. The first TCM is planned to take place on February 25, 2025.

TRANSPORTATION:

The Organizing Committee will provide free transfers for participating teams between the airport-hotel / hotel-airport / hotel-gondola / gondola-hotel. This service is available only from February 25 to March 2, 2025.

In the teams' transfer request information forms, the following details should be provided:

Number of people,

Arrival and departure dates, flight information (flight number, time, and destinations),

Luggage information (total weight, size, and number of bags, etc.).

ACCOMMODATION:

Teams' accommodation will be provided by Palandöken Ejder3200 Ski Resorts at a rate of 80 CHF per person (athlete, official, and staff) (Article 4.3.1). Accommodation will be in hotels that comply with FIS rules (Article 4.3). All beverages, except non-alcoholic drinks, will be subject to an additional charge. Accommodation payments will be made at the race office located at the Snowdora Hotel in Palandöken.

PRIZE MONEY:

All cash prizes will be awarded after the new FIS paid process. NSA's must manage all information for the prize money using the FIS athlete registration mode in the FIS member section. All bank information must be uploaded to the FIS database before the finals.

There will be a delay in paying athletes whose correct bank information is not uploaded to the FIS system.

In order to process the prize fee, all winners must provide valid bank information, identification information and appropriate tax documents in full.
