Sunday, February 23, 2025 - AERIAL

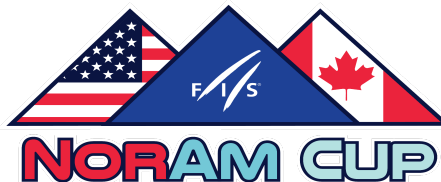

LICENSES

All athletes are required to have **an active FIS number**.

Coaches/athletes/officials that represent a Canadian team are required to have a valid FC license and all requirements related to its validation (background check, appropriate training, mandatory NCCP modules).



LIABILITY AND ACCIDENT INSURANCE

All athletes, officials and other members of the regions who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. Every competitor is required to have his/her own medical and life insurance that is adequate and covers the maneuvers being performed in training and competition. All athletes, coaches and officials must have a valid membership. The organizing committee, the P/TSO, the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, the resort and the Canadian Snowsports Association shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second- or third-party claims during the staging of the event. All participants are urged to always protect and safeguard their personal belongings.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Please note that there will be **ZERO TOLERANCE** for any offensive language or behavior during the event. Any damages or disruption to hotel, facilities or other property related to this event will result in the offender(s) being immediately removed from the event.

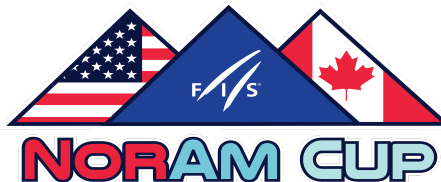

REFUNDS

COMPETITION OFFICE

Upon arrival at Lac Beauport each athlete should present himself or herself at the registration desk located in the Acrobatx water ramp building situated at the bottom of course 8C. Use south parking lot.



LIFT TICKETS

The bib will act as the lift ticket and it is required to access the aerial site.

Competitors: **Bibs are necessary**

Coaches: **No lift ticket necessary for the aerial site**

BIBS

A bib deposit of **CAD\$ 20.00** is required. **Cash only.** Bibs must be returned in good condition for a refund at the end of the event. All athletes on the course must wear bibs properly during official training and for all competitions as well as for medal ceremonies.

FIELD SIZE

In accordance with NAC 10.3- Quotas: Each nation is provided an equal number of quota spots for men and women; each nation is expected to provide equal opportunity per gender to fill spots. The quotas for the NorAm Cup Tour for AE events are as follows:

CAN	30
USA	30
Foreign Nations	40
Maximum Field Size	100

FORMAT

Each athlete in an individual NorAm aerial competition will usually be provided the opportunity to perform two jumps in a qualification round of competition. The athletes will be ranked based on their highest total score of the two jumps performed; the top six ranked athletes per gender will move on to the final round of competition (the "finals"). In the final round, each qualified athlete will perform a third jump; the third jump may be a repeat of a jump that was performed in the qualification round. The final results are based solely off the jumps performed in the final round.

SCORING

Freestyle Solutions Lite (formerly called World Cup Lite) scoring program will be used.
Live scoring link will be distributed when available.
