2. Rules

- Georgian Ski Federation, Mountain Resorts Development Company and the organizing committee of the FIS SNOWBOARD CROSS WORLD CUP are organizing the Snowboard Cross World Cup on March 7th – 9th, 2025; in Gudauri ski resort.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations of FIS Snowboard / Freestyle / Freeski World Cup Rules.
- This competition is a Snowboard Cross event and is open to both Men and women.
- This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to change the schedule depending on the snow conditions, weather, or decision of the competition jury.

3. Entries

Registration/Entries

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules.

All entries must be done using the FIS Online Registration System, through the FIS home page: <http://www.fis-ski.com/> "Member Section". FIS has established national quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations. **Deadlines for Team Entries:*****Preliminary Entries (women/men): 26.01.2025******Final Entries: 25.02.2025***

Competitors entered FIS Snowboard World Cups must have a minimum of 75 SBX Points. Additional Spots Minimum Participation Requirements: A minimum of 125 SBX FIS Points or Base Points (whichever are better) are required to use an additional quota spot in the SBX event.

4. Registration and Means of Payment

- **Participation Fee A Mandatory Participation Fee (competitors only) of a maximum of CHF 30 per official training and competition day will be charged to all entered competitors, based on the program in the official invitation. The invitation should clearly state the total amount to be paid by each competitor and event. The total amount cannot be more than CHF 120 per competitor.**
- **Double participation: the participation fee only has to be paid once (e.g. 1x Training-, 1 Qualification-, 2 Final days) or respectively up to the maximum of CHF 120.**
- **The Participation Fee has to be paid at the Race Office in cash or credit card.**
- **All teams are responsible for arriving and registering at the race office – located in Hotel “Marco Polo” on the first Team Captain’s meeting, March 5th.**
- **Accommodation with Half Board for the dates: 5 March - 9 March 2025, is CHF 80 per person per night.**

“No Shows” will be charged to the National Associations by LLC “TRIFECTA.”

7. Transfer

- Participants are responsible for their own transportation. Gudauri ski resort is located **144 km** away from Tbilisi International Airport, The OC offers transfers between the airport of Tbilisi and the resort (busses, minivans for teams, and trucks for equipment). Transfer requests are to be sent to office trifectasportstours@gmail.com and should include the following information:
 1. Arrival/departure date, time, flight numbers, destination (from/to)
 2. Number of passengers and all names of participants in a group
 3. Amount of luggage in pieces and its approximate total weight.

- The accommodation and transfer request should be sent no later than the **19th** of February 2025
- Competitors, coaches, and OC key staff will be accommodated in Hotel TBA.

10. **Accident Protocol**

- In case of an accident on the course during the event, medical staff from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to the Tbilisi Medical Centre or local hospital.
