World Cup Information

ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations (NSA) following FIS quotas and rules.

Please submit teams' provisional entries, including arrival and departure dates, and accommodation details for all team members (officials, service, coaches and athletes) by **January 27, 2025. Final entries are due February 28, 2025.**

All entries and updates must be completed using the FIS online registration system access through the FIS FOU member section.

FIS has established nation quotas for World Cup events. NSA's can only enter competitors according to quota limitations. Link to the Quotas: <https://assets.fis-ski.com/f/252177/x/ddfab59083/wc-quotas-2425-1st-calculation-ski-cross.pdf>

REGISTRATION

On-site team registration will take place at the Holiday Inn Express in Collingwood (500 Hume Street) **March 9th and 10th, 2025** between 9:00 and 18:00. The Race Office will relocate to the Craigleith Ski Resort, South Lodge, as of March 11th. All fees and deposits must be paid at time of registration. All Teams **MUST** be registered in advance of the Team Captains' meeting.

ACCOMMODATION & WAX ROOMS

Teams will be hosted at the Holiday Inn Express in Collingwood (500 Hume Street) per the FIS World Cup rules from **Monday, March 10, 2025 to Saturday, March 15, 2025.**

Information on Team Wax spaces to follow.

As per the FIS rules on accommodation (half board, max. 2 people per room / 2 beds) all competitors and team officials must pay the organising committee the CAD (cash or credit card only) equivalent of 60CHF per day. The number of competitors per country may not exceed the total quota. Each team must pay accommodation expenses on arrival day. No reservations or payments will be accepted from competitors. Each team will be responsible for any damages incurred during their stay.

The official single room quota is 2 single rooms per team. Allocation of additional single rooms per team must be provided at a rate of CHF 120 in accordance with the following:

- 3 or 4 officials = 1 additional single room
- 5 or 6 officials = 2 additional single rooms
- 7 or more officials = 3 additional single rooms

If more single rooms are requested, this will be subject to availability and local market rates will apply.

The same conditions apply for officials, following the below chart of officials / team size:

Team Size Ski Cross:

1-3 competitors	5 officials or accompanying persons
4 competitors	6 officials or accompanying persons
5 competitors	7 officials or accompanying persons
6-7 competitors	9 officials or accompanying persons
8 or more competitors	14 officials or accompanying persons

Conditions for additional officials will follow the FIS rules: Accommodation and half-board will be charged equivalent to CHF 70, per day, and the number of those officials is limited to 25% of the total quota

New this year: The accommodation expenses for the top 5 women and the top 5 men in the World Cup will be covered by the Organizing Committee. The hotels accommodating the Top 5 men and women will be contacted directly by the Organizing Committee regarding billing.

Rooms will be allocated according to team entries. **No shows will be charged to NSA's.**

IMPORTANT: In order to properly accommodate all athletes, coaches, officials, etc. we require preliminary entries **as soon as possible.**

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to and from Craigleith is the responsibility of the individual national teams. All international flights should be scheduled into Toronto Pearson International Airport.

ACCREDITATION

All teams and registered officials will receive accreditation upon registration. Accreditation must be worn at all times. Lost or stolen accreditations may be replaced at a fee.

BIBS

All competitors must wear their bibs during all official training and competition.

LIABILITY

All athletes, officials and other members of the NSA who will be in attendance and/or participate in the competition shall do so at their own risk of any injuries or losses suffered or incurred during the competition block.

INSURANCE

Every competitor must have their own medical insurance. In the case of accidents on course during competition, qualification or training, the medical personnel from the organising committee will be responsible to the local hospital for any medical decisions in collaboration with the respective teams' medical personnel.

ANTI-DOPING

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.
