The AGM 2025 will take place from 30.03. – 03.04.2025 at Kitzsteinhorn, Zell am See - Kaprun. Both Halfpipe and Slopestyle will be as well an Europa Cup.

ENTRY CRITERIA TO THE AUSTRIAN MASTERS BA – EC

- As this year the event will be held as Europa Cup, FIS License is necessary to get EC Points.
 - o The minimum requirement to participate in Slopestyle Europa Cup Competitions is: Minimum 10 FIS points or 75 WSPL Points in Slopestyle
 - o There is no Quota or FIS/WSPL Point restriction for Halfpipe
- As well riders without FIS License are welcome to collect World Rookie Rank or WSPL Points but will not get FIS points.

The competition will be held under FIS Rules and regulations for Snowboard. This competition is a Snowboard Slopestyle and Half Pipe Europa Cup and is open to both men and women. This competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants. The organizing committee reserves the right to change the schedule depending on snow conditions, weather, or by the decision of the competition jury.

Bibs & Helmets:

All competitors must wear their BIBS during all official trainings and competition. BIBS have to be returned immediately after the competitions. € 20,- will be charged deposit for the BIBS. All competitors have to wear helmets through official training, qualification and finals.

Accident Protocol:

In case of accidents on courses during the event, medical personnel from the Organizing Committee and Ski Patrol will be responsible for any medical decision or evacuation to local hospital

Anti-Doping:

Anti-Doping control may be deducted.
