The regular snowpark will be open on Friday. Due to an event organised by Nitro snowboards, the EC setup will remain closed on Friday.

## **Rules**

Xbrigade is organizing a FIS Freestyle Ski and Snowboard competition for rails, part of the 2025-2026 Continental Cup of the International Ski Federation (FIS) Tour.

- The dates for this competition have been published in the FIS Events Calendar.
- The competition will be held under FIS rules and regulations.
- The competition will follow an official program that will be available to all participants.

- The OC, subject to the approval of the FIS and the jury, reserves the right to modify the published event schedule if necessary.

## **Entries, Quotas and Important Forms**

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations in accordance with FIS quotas and rules. Online registration is available through the FIS Member Section: <http://www.fis-ski.com>

All entries must follow the FIS Rules for the Continental Cup 2025- 2026. Only competitors entered by national associations are eligible, and participant numbers are subject to current quota limits.

## **Registration / Ski Pass**

Team registration will take place at SnowWorld Antwerp on **Saturday, 27th of September 2025**, from 9:00 AM till 10:00 AM. All fees (50 euros including entrance for saturday) must be paid at registration. Each athlete and official must have their ski pass on them during training and competition.

## **Bibs**

All competitors must wear bibs during official training and competition.

## **Entry Fee**

An entry fee of 50 euros will be charged for the competition on Saturday. Ski pass is included.

## **Liability**

All athletes, officials, and other participants attend at their own risk. The OC, Xbrigade, SnowWorld Antwerp, sponsors, and associated partners are not responsible for any losses or injuries incurred during the event. Please secure your personal belongings.

### **Prize Money**

Prize money will be awarded at each FIS Europa Cup event based on the total number of competitors in each gender category.

Additional prize money/ goodies will be offered. Final amounts will be announced at the TC meeting prior to each competition.

### **Accident Insurance**

Each competitor must have personal medical insurance. The OC and partners assume no responsibility for accidents, equipment damage, or third-party claims.

### **Accident Protocol**

Medical personnel and ski patrol will coordinate any necessary evacuation or medical care in consultation with national team medical staff.

### **Anti-Doping Control**

Anti-doping controls may be conducted for each gender.

### **Ski Storage / Wax Cabin**

Competitors and team officials must use designated areas at their accommodation for ski storage and waxing.
