All athletes must previously have signed the FIS Athletes Declaration Form in order to register and compete.

We look forward to hosting you all in Arosa during the FIS Ski Cross World Cup competition for the upcoming season 2025/26.

Registration/Entries

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules.

The preliminary entries date is November 5th, 2025 and the final entries of your competition team (competitors, officials, and other staff) with your arrival and departure dates (Names, FIS code for the participants and Gender) must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than December 5th 2025.

For any changes notified after this deadline, the organizing committee may invoice the costs incurred for cancelled accommodation to the National Ski Association concerned. Teams or persons who register late have no right to reservation at the FIS rate.

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cups. National Ski Teams can only enter World Cup Ski Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded: <https://assets.fis-ski.com/f/252177/x/ddfab59083/wc-quotas-2425-1st-calculation-ski-cross.pdf>

Competitors entered into FIS Ski Cross World Cups must have the minimum required FIS Ski Cross points in one of the valid FIS points list.

Minimum FIS Point Standards to Participate in a FIS Ski Cross World Cup:

Standards/ Requirements	Ski Cross FIS Points
Minimum FIS Points	100
Alpine FIS Points list rank in any event	Top 50

Accommodation

Teams will be accommodated in several hotels or residences *** and more on a half-board basis from Sunday evening the 14th of December to Wednesday 17th of December (3 nights).

Each team will pay the total of the accommodation expenses at their arrival to the hotel. Each team will be held responsible for any damage incurred during the stay. Any kind of extras like phone, laundry, mini bar and pay-TV must be paid by the teams or athletes directly at the hotel. "No Shows" will be charged to the National Associations directly at the Hotel.

The FIS' rate is 80CHF/night/pax. The LOC will waive the FIS rate for the top 5 men / women as per the current SXWC standing.

For officials (representatives of a National Ski Association, trainers, doctors, technicians and official accompanying persons) of teams with a World Cup quota the costs for lodging and food (half board) must be guaranteed at the rate of CHF 80 according to the following:

Team Size Ski Cross:

- 1-3 competitors = 5 officials or accompanying persons
- 4 competitors = 6 officials or accompanying persons
- 5 competitors = 7 officials or accompanying persons
- 6-7 competitors = 9 officials or accompanying persons
- 8 or more competitors = 14 officials or accompanying persons

Additional officials are limited to 25% of the total quota and charged for CHF 110.

The official single room FIS' quota is 2 single rooms per team.

Allocation of additional single rooms per team must be provided at a rate of CHF 120 according to the following table:

- 3 or 4 officials = 1 additional single room
- 5 or 6 officials = 2 additional single rooms
- 7 or more officials = 3 additional single rooms

SRS who are not directly related to a national team will be charged for a rate at CHF 110/night/pax for a double room and CHF 150/night/pax.

If more single rooms are requested, this will be subject to availability and local market rates will apply.

Transportation from Zurich Airport to Arosa

All teams are responsible for their own transportation arrangements. Please allow about 3 hours travel time from Zurich Airport to Arosa by train/car/coach.

By train: From Zurich Airport - Intercity trains to Chur, then by Rhaetian Railway in 60 minutes to Arosa.

By car: Highway from Zurich to Chur and then about 45 minutes up a winding mountain road (30 kilometres). Car Rentals at the Airport possible.

The competitors must wear bibs during the official trainings, competition and award ceremonies.

Every competitor must have his/her own medical insurance (it will be necessary to show your evidence of medical and insurance cover).

Anti-Doping Control

Anti-Doping control testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

Prize Money

The total prize purse for is Euro 69,842* per FIS rules. The prize money breakdown is in accordance with the FIS rules and all money transfers will be made electronically within 14 business days after the event. In order to process the money transfers accordingly, we ask you to review and doublecheck the bank account information for each athlete at the FIS Member Section.
