- Foreign inscriptions will be considered on a first come first serve basis.
- A Maximum of 10 competitors per gender will be accepted for the start.
- If there are more than 10 applicants, then athletes will be selected based off of their current FIS point ranking as of September 30, 2025.
- National teams will be notified of the official event entry by October 1, 2025 so they may register online.
- If any competitor drops, the list will be adjusted as needed to reflect the top 10 competitors per gender.

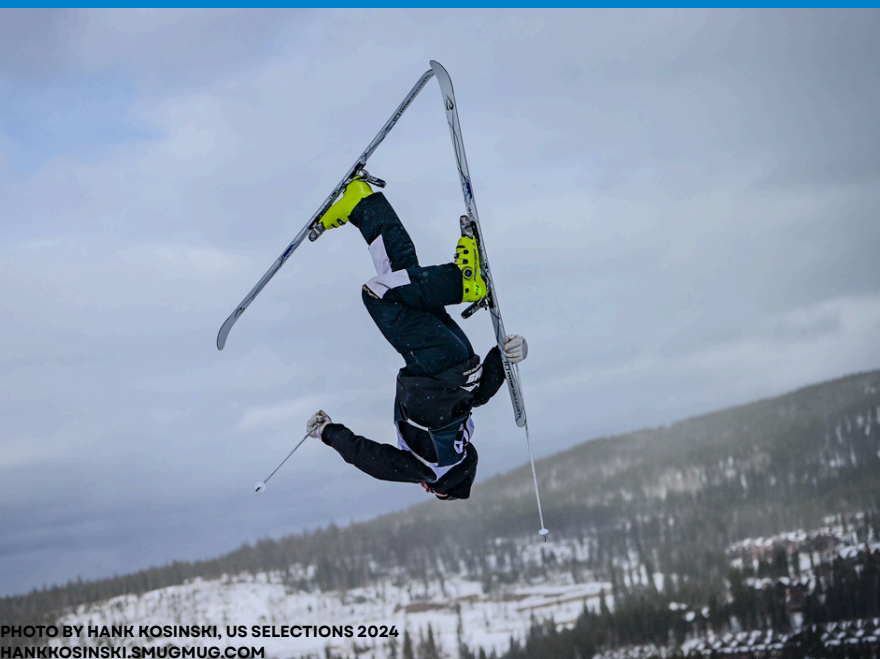
