# REGISTRATION & TEAM CAPTAIN'S MEETING

Registration will take place in the Violet Room at the ALT Hotel. Hours of Operation will be posted at a later date.

A registration fee of 200 CHF will be charged for each athlete to register for the event. This includes access to all official training days, qualifications and finals.

All invoices for this event will be created for the whole nation, as registered on the FIS online portal. If a change needs to be made to an invoice, please provide plenty of advance notice.

Prepayment before the nation's arrival is preferred and encouraged. Payment via credit card will be accepted onsite, but is discouraged.

# ACCOMMODATIONS

Athlete accommodation will be provided at the [ALT Hotel University District](#) in University District Calgary. Should the capacity of the hotel be reached, overflow accommodation will be provided at the [ALT Hotel East Village](#) in East Village Calgary. This will be communicated to registered nations by the OC as needed.

Accommodations need to be booked in the FIS online registration form. The OC uses the online submission to make all accommodation reservations. Ensure that the arrival/departure dates, roommates, dietary requirements, etc. are correct online. The OC will only accept room changes, additions and cancellations done through the FIS portal. Please do not contact the host hotel as they will not be able to offer the same rates. All accommodations requirements and/or requests **MUST** be imputed into the FIS registration system by **November 23, 2025**.

The following rates are for **double** rooms:

80 CHF per person/ per night incl. Breakfast & Dinner (for teams in accordance to FIS WC)

110 CHF per person/ per night incl. Breakfast & Dinner (for additional support staff in accordance to FIS WC)

Price will vary for single rooms requested. Please contact the OC ([snowrodeo@freestylecanada.ski](mailto:snowrodeo@freestylecanada.ski)) to request pricing details. Please note: tourism fees of 10% will be added to all accommodation fees on the nation's invoices. At the time of check-in, a fully-refundable damage deposit will be required for each room, payable on any major credit card. Each NSO will be held responsible for any damage incurred during their stay.

# CANCELLATIONS/ NO SHOWS

Cancellations of any accommodations **MUST** be done through the FIS online registration system. The OC does not accept any cancellation or changes via email.

Any bookings (athletes or support staff) that are canceled on or after **December 21, 2025**, are subject to cancellation fees. Cancellation charges will be billed directly to the nation and payment expected within 30 days.

All accommodation no-shows will be subject to cancellation fees, these will be billed directly to the nation and payment expected within 30 days.

# MEALS & TRANSPORTATION

## BREAKFAST & DINNER

Commencing with dinner on Sunday December 28 and ending with breakfast on Sunday January 4.

The meal plan will be offered at the host hotel.

Half-board accommodation includes breakfast and dinner provided at the host hotel.

Lunch will be at the cost of athletes and/or teams.

# BIBS & EQUIPMENT STORAGE

## BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during official training, competition and award ceremonies. The same bibs will be used from training until the end of the competition and the award ceremonies.

## Equipment Storage

Teams are eligible to leave snowboard in their room(s), ONLY if they are laid flat on the ground and do not incur any damages to the hotel property. Snowboards cannot be tuned or worked on inside hotel rooms.

Wax facilities are provided at the host hotels. These facilities will be in the parking garage of the hotels and identified to you at registration. Teams are responsible for their own tuning space and are required to ensure that no tuning materials are left unattended.



# LIABILITY

All athletes officials and other members of their National Sport Association who attend and Participate in the event shall do so at their own risk.

The OC, WinSport, The Canadian Snowsports Association, FIS, Freestyle Canada, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers, shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organization or staging of the event. All participants are urged not to be negligent in safeguarding their personal belongings at all times.
