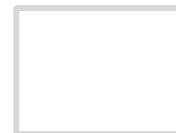

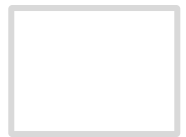

All registrations in the FIS system have been received and accommodation has been reserved as specified for the teams that booked through us.

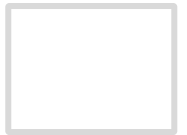

Transport

FRA is the main airport

The transportation office will arrange transportation between the official airport (Frankfurt am Main, München, Leipzig) and the team hotel in Oberhof.

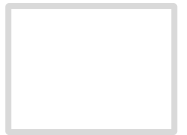
Additional costs may apply for different airports.

Shuttle service between team hotel and venue (walking distance 3,5km).

One transport per team (from the official airport to the team hotel and one from the team hotel to the airport) and shuttle on site (team hotel - venue) is free of charge. Requests for transportation (exact arrival times, flight numbers and number of arriving people) must be sent via the FIS Online Entry System or directly to the Transportation office at transport@weltcup-oberhof.de.

Reimbursement

The LOC covers the travel and accommodation costs according to the FIS rules for the red group. Teams which organized the booking of accommodation on their own and have entitlement to reimbursement because of the red group have to contact the LOC and send us an invoice about the costs.

Teams which organized accommodation via the LOC, will get an invoice by the LOC after the event. Please tell us your invoice address and the contact details for the invoice with the booking.

Every team receives an invoice after the event. Teams that have entitlement to reimbursement receive a credit.

Prize money

Prize Money will be paid by bank transfer to the athletes after the event. The prize money is regulated by the FIS World Cup Rules.

If needed receipts will be provided to the athlete electronically and a copy transmitted to FIS. Remember to upload bank info using the FIS Athlete

Waxing facilities

Wax cabins:

Available from THU 15.01.26.

If you want to have access to the wax cabins before thursday, please contact us.

The keys to the waxing cabins are available at the team area. Keys return to LOC info on the day of departure. Payment for additional wax cabins (over Quota) must be made when picking up the keys. Fee for lost key 100€ and cleaning fee 150€. Parking cards can be picked up together with the keys.

A race doctor is on duty in the ski stadium area during the event.

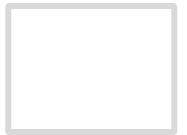
At the moment, Germany does not have any restriction on entry to the country.

Regulations of radio equipment/Radio Frequencies

The import, export and the operation of radio equipment in Germany is regulated by national law. The radio frequencies need to be authorized by the regulatory authority. Unauthorized use is liable to prosecution. Fines of up to EUR 500.000 may be imposed.
