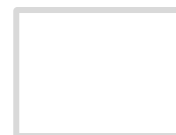

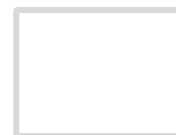

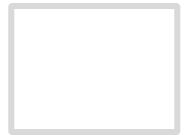

Logistical information

Accommodation (World Cup Rules Art.13)

Booking according to the FIS Rules via the FIS Online registration system.

Bookings can only be made by the tourist board Seefeld: sonja.seelos@seefeld.com

If you have a preferred hotel, please inform the tourist board Seefeld as soon as possible: sonja.seelos@seefeld.com

The booked hotels include full board until Thursday. Friday, Saturday and Sunday will be with half board and lunch on-site.

Additional information about the accommodation will be given to the teams after receiving preliminary entry and accommodation request.

Accommodation costs: The OC will pay for persons within the quota according to the FIS Rules. Costs for persons not in the quota and all extras are payable directly in the hotels.

You will find a reserved parking area for accreditation pick-up at Möserer Str. 632, 6100 Seefeld in Tirol. After picking up your accreditations, we kindly ask you to park your car at the designated parking areas.

The accreditation must be worn on your person at all times, except by athletes immediately before, during and after the competition.

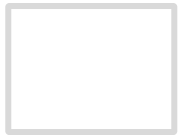
The accreditation must in no circumstances whatsoever be given to third parties.

Transport

Official airport: Munich and Innsbruck

The organizing committee will arrange transportation between the airport and the hotels. One (1) transport (from/to the airport) free of charge. Only teams, no single persons! To get a smooth settlement we kindly ask you to contact the race office early enough to register for the transportation: arena@seefeld-sports.at

Transport from/to the hotel-venue: Limited shuttle possible. Preferred transport with own team vehicles. Only use the allocated and designated parking space for your team (red parking space (A) near the jumping area for one (1) car. Further cars at the WM Halle, Mösererstrasse 632 (B). Drop-off area in the WM Arena available.

Prize money

Waxing facilities

Wax cabins: Every nation is assigned a waxing cabin by the organiser. The keys can be picked up at the race office.

Deposit: € 50,- per cabin. The cabins are available from Tuesday the 27th of January 2026.

Wax trucks: Teams arriving with a wax truck must inform the OC until 10th of January 2026 with exact measurements of the truck and other important details: arena@seefeld-sports.at

Please be aware that teams arriving with a wax truck will not receive any wax cabin but only changing rooms according to the FIS rules.

Testing protocol by LOC or host country

Regulations of radio equipment/Radio Frequencies

We would like to inform you that there have been several changes regarding TKGV fees (Telecommunications Fees Ordinance):

- For the calculation of the fees, it is no longer the number of radio systems that is decisive, but the **number of frequencies used**
- Another important factor is the **area of use** as well as the **frequency range** (see [BGBLA 2024 II 356.pdfsig.pdf](#)).
- A key point concerns the registration **deadline for radio systems**

If an application is submitted **less than 14 days before the event, double the fee will be charged**

All locations in Austria where the devices are to be operated should already be reported at this stage in order to avoid double charging of fees.

Please make sure to fill in the linked [registration form](#) and send to: office@fb.gv.at

All used frequencies must be registered with and authorized by the regulatory authority. A fine up to € 4000,- may apply for unregistered radios.

Representatives of the authority will be on site during the World Cup to check that all radios are registered.

Regulations of Visa

Remember that citizens of some countries will need a visa to visit Austria. Please check with your embassy if you need a visa for Austria.

Special permissions for truck driving (Sunday and night, other days with special regulations)
