Competition Rules

FIS rules will be applied to this competition

Entries

Entries will be accepted only from National Ski Associations via the FIS entry system following FIS quotas and rules. Please submit the anticipated number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the names of participants as per rule 4.2 in the Rules for the FIS Snowboard/Freestyle Ski/Freeski World Cups.

The preliminary number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) must be submitted to the organizing committee no later than the **30th of January 2026**.

The names of participants must be submitted via the FIS entry system no later than the **1st March 2026 (Final Entries)** as per rule 4.2.1 in the Rules for the FIS Snowboard/Freestyle Ski/Freeski World Cups.

Access to the online registration system is through FIS Homepage <http://www.fis-ski.com> then go to Member Section.

FIS has established nation Quotas for World Cups. National Snowboard Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the Quota limitations. The Quotas can be downloaded:

Accommodation and Wax Rooms

Teams will be hosted for lodging and meals at different partner hotels as per the FIS Snowboard World Cup rules (4 nights at the FIS rate, CHF 80,-) from Monday 9th to Friday 13th March 2026. Earlier arrivals or later departures than the official arriving/departure day do not guarantee the FIS rate.

Official Arriving Day: 9th March 2026

Official Departure Day: 13th March 2026

As per the FIS Snowboard/Freestyle Ski/Freeski World Cup Rules on accommodation and half pension, all competitors and team officials will pay the Euro equivalent of 80 Swiss Francs per day.

Each coach has to pay his/her team accommodation expenses on arrival day directly in the Hotel. No reservation and no payment will be accepted from the competitors. Each team will be responsible for any damage incurred during their stay. Wax rooms will be at all partner hotels.

Cancellation until 10 days before the first training day are free of charge. Cancellation 10 days or less before the first training day can be charged individually by the hotel.

The change of the entire team ratio (competitors, officials, service personnel) may not exceed 20% of the original number. Teams that exceed 20% have no right for the reservation or the guarantee of the official rate. For Teams which cancel more than 20% the organiser may ask a cancellation fee up to the official room rate for the cancellations exceeding the 20%.

Additional rooms out of the quote or additional single rooms exceeding the quote have to be paid by the NSA also directly in the hotel at the respective FIS-Rate (additional officials - World Cup Rules 4.3.3) or hotel price.

Registration / Race Office

Team registration will take place daily starting on Monday 9th March 2026 at the Tourism Office in St. Gallenkirch (Montafonerstraße 2, 6791 St. Gallenkirch). The accreditation can only be created by registering in the FIS entry system. One representative per team can collect all accreditations.

Ceremonies, Public Draw, Side Events

Rules

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify the schedule of the event stated in the program, depending on the snow conditions or the decision of the competition jury.

Bibs

The competitors wear bibs during trainings, competition and award ceremonies. Please note that there will be a deposit of € 20,- for each bib, payable only in cash at the race office.

Transportations/Directions

Teams are responsible for their own transportation.

Prize Money

The prize money breakdown is in accordance with the FIS rules and all money transfers will be made electronically within 7 business days after the event.

In order to process the money transfers accordingly, we ask you to review and doublecheck the bank account information for each athlete at the FIS Member Section on the FIS Website.
