Early Program Information for Lake Placid, USA

Eligibility: Only athletes who have been registered by their national ski associations are eligible to participate.

Registration process: Team registrations, including athletes and team staff, should be made via the FIS online registration system (FIS Entry System).

Accommodations: Accommodation bookings for teams and officials must be made via the FIS registration system. The Lake Placid LOC will assign a hotels to teams. You will be informed by e-mail regarding your assigned locations.

The cancellation conditions listed in the FIS regulations apply. Those who organize their own accommodation are requested to inform us of where they are staying. Please email cleist@orda.org

Accreditation system: Accreditation for teams, technicians, coaches, officials and service companies must be requested via the FIS online system. Physical accreditation (bibs and passes) will be provided at a special accreditation office located in the Athlete Services Tent.

Official Airport : Montréal-Pierre Elliott Trudeau International Airport in Montreal, QC, Canada It is approximately 2.5 hours from Lake Placid, NY depending on city and/or border traffic.

When Teams Land: The LOC will have staff onsite to meet/greet the teams, and a room at the Marriott In-Terminal Hotel to stage teams, gear, and coaches while they wait for the buses. The LOC will direct everyone to the room and will provide stickers to label all gear by team/nation.

Due to travel distance from the host airport the LOC will connect different arrival times to reduce the number of trips to and from Lake Placid, *this timetable will be provided in the coming weeks.* **Nations that choose to fly in or out of another location other than Montreal (YUL) will incur additional transportation costs.**

The LOC will provide:

- Only one free of charge transfer per team from the **official airport to the venue and one from the venue to the airport.**
- Transportation between the Airport and Hotel **only** for the staff included in the staff quota.

The arriving and departing times MUST be communicated to the OC latest 8 days before arrival.
