17. CHANGE LOG

1. ENTRIES

The FIS Online Registration System must be used to register the participating teams.

Preliminary entry counts as a wax cabin booking. An extra wax cabin must be ordered using the entry system.

Note that the Nordic World Cup event has an earlier preliminary entry deadline.

2. ACCOMMODATION

HOTEL

The Nordic combined teams are accommodated at Hotel Fennada (Vierumäki Sports Centre). Vierumäki is about 30 km from the venue.

FIS ONLINE REGISTRATION SYSTEM

Teams and SRS companies must use the FIS online booking system to request the number of rooms, SGL/DBL with full board, and arrival and departure dates. NSA who are not using the online system and do not respect the deadlines are losing their rights to World Cup prices and conditions.

The OC will cover accommodation costs in accordance with the reimbursement lists in the rules (Article 6.2.1)

Over-quota payments

- Teams will be directly responsible for over-quota accommodation costs to the OC.
- Over-quota accommodation will be invoiced. It can be paid on-site at the accommodation office with a credit card or via bank transfer.
- Travel Money will be reduced from the accommodation invoice.
- Please provide your invoice address to accommodation@lahtiskigames.com before the pre-entry deadline.

Cancellation rules and fees

- A 100% cancellation fee will be charged for cancellations made between 8 days before the first race and the end of the events (departure date chosen by the team).
- For earlier cancellations exceeding the allowed limit stated in the rules, the LOC will charge a 100% cancellation fee. Please refer to Article 6.2.1.1 of the Nordic Combined World Cup rules for detailed information about the cancellation rules and deadlines.

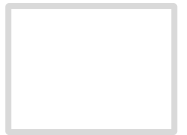

3. CATERING

TEAM'S LUNCH RESERVATIONS

Lunch reservations for the hotel or venue must be submitted through FIS online entry by 27 February 2026.

Due to the competition schedule, some lunches will be at the stadium. The OC will serve warm meals for the Nordic Combined teams in the Cross-Country service area building.

Thursday lunch: NC women & NC men at the venue

Friday lunch: NC women at the venue (*NC men at the hotel*)

Saturday lunch: NC women & NC men at the venue

Your accommodation confirmation email will include details about lunches on other days.

Meal Card

- Team members receive a meal card at hotel check-in; show it for lunch/dinner at the venue and hotel restaurant—keep it with you.
- Meals are preloaded based on entry arrival/departure times; if the card malfunctions, contact hotel reception or the Cross-Country Race Office at the venue.
- This supports sustainability by reducing food waste and optimising deliveries; the venue's lunch menu can be accessed via the QR code.
- Teams/SRS booking their own accommodation can buy lunch (meal cards) from the CC Race Office.

Venue lunch price without OC accommodation

Teams and SRS that do not book accommodation through OC and arrange their own accommodation must pay for team lunches at the venue, booking via the FIS online entry system by the entry deadline.

The lunch price is 10 EUR per person/day. Payments to the race office by credit card.

Lunch times at the venue

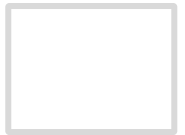

The tickets for the Nordic Combined athletes are area tickets and will be distributed from the race office for the team leaders.



5. TRANSPORT

AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

The official airport is Helsinki Airport (94 km from Lahti).

The organising committee can arrange transportation between the official airport and the hotel. **Only one free transfer per team from the airport to the venue and one from the venue to the airport.**

- Teams must send the precise arrival times, flight or ferry numbers, and the total number of arriving people, including the amount of luggage, to the organiser **at the latest eight (8) days before arrival via the FIS Online Entry system.**
- The cost for outside quota and extra transportation is 55€ per person one-way.
- **Make transportation payments to the shuttle office in the cross-country service area building by credit card within opening hours:** Thu-Fri 10-17, Sat 9-17.
- Teams booking accommodation independently are responsible for their own transportation. They may request paid transportation from the OC at transportation@lahtiskigames.com at least eight days before arrival. (Transportation for teams booking OC accommodation is provided as a priority.)

The departure of booked transports

The bus station for the booked transports is located in front of the airport terminal at the same level as arrivals. Follow the "charter" signs after exiting the gate.

The team host is available to assist in the arrivals hall from Tuesday, 3.3. to Thursday, 5.3.

SHUTTLE

The OC provides a scheduled shuttle between the official hotels and the stadium. Time schedules will be uploaded to the event website closer to the event and can be found at the hotel reception and service area during the event. Shuttle booking system

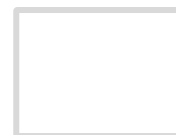

The prize money payment is in accordance with the World Cup Rules. OC will use a protected FIS database for prize money payment information. Please ensure that all your athletes' data is uploaded to the system before the competition weekend (including Tax codes).

Tax identification number

8. TEAM SERVICES

WAXING FACILITIES, TEAM AREAS & OFFICES

The Nordic Combined and Ski Jumping service area is next to the ski jumping hills. Address: Suurmäenkatu 5, FI-15900 Lahti.

The Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined race office is located next to the large hill tower at the white container.

Waxing facilities are next to the hill. Athletes' Rooms and Team Area are in the building below the large hill. Team Café offers snacks during its opening hours.

The Cross-Country service area building contains accommodation, financial, transportation, and team host offices. Address: Suurmäenkatu 4, FI-15900 Lahti.

Wax cabins

You can collect the keys from the race office starting on Wednesday. Early arrivals can pick up the keys at the Team Café.

- You will need to deposit 100€ to get the keys. Please note that the keys must be returned no later than the day of departure or, at the latest, the day after the last competition.

Pay for extra wax cabins or power supplies by credit card during key pickup.

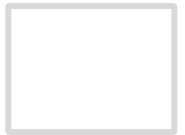
Please ensure that all garbage is emptied into recycling bins and that the wax cabins are clean. Drilling or screwing into the walls is prohibited in containers.

- OC charges €150 for cleaning each dirty wax cabin or to repair wall holes. When the keys are handed over, LOC will inspect the wax cabins.

A financial penalty (CHF 900 per cabin) to the NSA or company that has ordered waxing cabins and has not shown up.

Waxing trucks and changing vehicles:

- Teams and SRS must submit requested vehicles via pre-entry by Jan 10th, 2026.
- Priority parking in the service area, based on distance to the stadium, will be given to the wax trucks. If the service area cannot accommodate all vehicles, teams' secondary vehicles will be directed to the nearest parking facility.
- In addition to the wax truck, each team can apply for one parking permit for a smaller vehicle in the online entry system. For more information, see the parking section below.
- **Confirm the truck's arrival date, time and driver's phone number for service area parking at kalle.lepisto@icloud.com by Sunday, 15th February.**
- Trucks may park in the service area from Monday, 2nd March, until the truck's arrival deadline on Wednesday, 4th March.

Parking in the venue

Parking is prohibited in the service area. Drop-off in the service area is possible.

The parking area is near the cross-country skiing course at the "dog field" 150-200m from the service area. Each team will receive only one parking permit. Parking permit from the accreditation office.

Access the "dog field" parking area via Hämeenlinnantie:

When driving from the city centre, continue past the jumping hill and the Cross-Country service area intersection. Then, turn right at the next intersection from Hämeenlinnantie to Vaskelaisrinne. Immediately after, make another right turn, and you'll reach the parking area from this road.

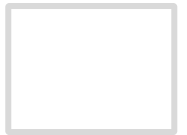

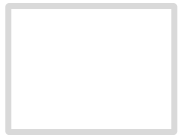

The Finnish Transport and Communications Agency (Traficom) regulate the use of radio frequencies in Finland. Based on submitted applications, Traficom issues radio licenses for radio transmitter users to ensure trouble-free utilisation of the radio spectrum.

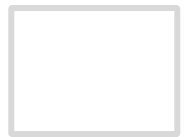
