FIS Europa Cup Rail The Hague December 18th - 21st 2025

1. General information

Rock a Rail is an established international rail event, celebrating its 12th birthday in 2025. Taking place in The Hague's city Centre, the event attracts thousands of spectators on site and many more online each year. The best rail riding athletes in the world have made their appearance at this spectacular event, many of them will again make their way to The Hague for this edition.

Since 2024, Rock a Rail is sanctioned as a FIS EC rail, providing opportunities for athletes to acquire points for the new and separate Rail ranking.

Qualifications will be on Thursday 18th of December in the indoor facility De Uithof within 15 km of the event venue. The main events will take place on the event location "Koekamp" next to The Hague Central Station. Freeski finals will take off on Friday 19th of December, while Snowboard will take place on the 20th.

For finals, the riders qualified will be joined by freeskiers and snowboarders previously qualified at the Rock a Rail events in Thun and Innsbruck, as well as some other world class rail riders. More info about the event www.rockarail.tv and www.snowfest.eu

2. Entries and important forms

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. Please enter through the FIS Online Entry tool in the member section of the FIS website.

For the 2025-2026 season, no minimum points are required to enter Europa Cup rail. Please note that Rock a Rail provides a very high-level street set up. Please only enter athletes capable of riding such structures.

Definitive registration by name no later **than Sunday December 7th**.

Team registration will take place at De Uithof on Thursday December 18th from 15:00-17:00 at the registration office at De Uithof.

3. Accommodation

The Hague offers a large variety of places to stay in different price ranges. We advise you to look online for the best options. We can recommend the Moxxy hotel in the centre of The Hague.

4. Transportation

Teams are responsible for their own transportation. The Hague provides a good public transportation network. Check out <https://9292.nl/en/> for more info on public transportation.



6. Meals

On Final days Friday 19th & Saturday 20th December, dinner will be provided for qualified athletes by the OC on site.

7. Bibs

During qualifications on Thursday 18th, bibs will be provided by the organization and are mandatory to wear.

8. Accident Insurance

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, Rock a Rail, the training and qualification venues, the FIS and the Netherlands Ski Federation decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second- and third-party claims during the event.

9. Liability

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, Rock a Rail, the training and qualification venue, the Netherlands Ski Federation, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees, and volunteers shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.

Official training will take place before the qualification event on December 18th. The dome will be open for training during the whole week, and for all registered athletes there will be a discounted price to train. On final days, at the Koekamp location, training/ warm up will take place before each heat.

The entry fee for the Europa Cup rail is € 50, -. This includes the training and qualification on 18th December.
