Eligibility

Eligibility for participation is open to all National Sports Associations (NSA) affiliated with FIS

The competitor must be a citizen of the country of which NSA they have a license with and must have a valid FIS license

In all events a maximum of 6 women and men may start per event, per nation

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Awards

Flower and medal ceremonies will take place on the mountain at the end of each competition final. The top 6 placing athletes are required to attend these ceremonies and should be available for media interviews immediately after the awards.

Team Captains Meeting

The schedule for Team Captains Meetings will be shared with all registered nations prior to the event. All Team Captains Meetings will take place at the Alt Hotel University District (482 McLaurin St NW), roughly a 12 minute drive from the Resort.

Wax Space

The waxing space will be located in the parkade at the Alt Hotel University District (482 McLaurin St NW). Please note this is a public space and teams will be responsible for their own belongings and ensure that no tuning materials or equipment is left unattended.

Entries will be accepted in accordance with the FIS quotas and rules. All entries must be submitted by the athlete's National Sports Association using the FIS Online Registration System, through the Member Section of the FIS Homepage.

Team Leader

All teams must identify a single team leader as the on-site contact when submitting team entry through the FIS system.

Please distinguish this person as the "On Venue Contact" and include on-site phone and email information. This person will be responsible for all communication to/from the LOC prior to and during the event. With the team leaders phone numbers, we will create a group WhatsApp to communicate all important information.

Competitor Bibs

Training and competition bibs will be allocated at the first Team Captain's Meeting. It is mandatory for all competitors to wear their bibs when training and competing.

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COMPETITION VENUE

WinSport Canada Olympic Park is conveniently located in the City of Calgary. This venue is one of the key legacy facilities from the 1988 Winter Olympics and is home to a world-class halfpipe, slopestyle course, and terrain park. For more information on the venue visit their website [here](#).
