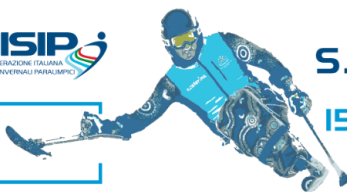

Accommodation

Sunday 14.12.25 in race office (start of Gondola) from 4.00 pm to 7.00 pm for skipass and check the list; only 1 coach can access to the race office at a time; all coaches must present themselves, no ski passes will be distributed the following morning.

MEDICAL RESCUE PLAN

The Techinc Ski S.S.D. a R.L. has written the following health plan on the basis of the indications present in the Italian regulations - CONFERENCE OF THE REGIONS AND AUTO PROVINCES act n°91 5th August 2014 and in the regulations of the International Ski Federation (FIS) + Update 2020.

The event will take place on the “D.Compagnoni” slope in S.Caterina V. from 14 to 17 December 2025

Medical Team and race course rescue:

At the start:

1 anaesthesiologist- emergency doctor, who is also the coordinating doctor in charge (Dott. Mauro Boccardi);

1 ski patrol rescue team Guardia di Finanza;

1 emergency nurse with experience in advanced mountain rescue;

Halfway down the track- start of the skilift;

1 ski patrol rescue team Guardia di Finanza

At the finish line:

emergency rescue ambulances with driver, emergency nurse and BLS provider.

In case of evacuation by helicopter, these rescuers will interface with the Areu Lombardia Helicopter crew.



The race doctor will be in constant radio contact with the race judge, with the medical staff on the track and with the medical staff down. The race doctor will coordinate and interface any hospitalization of injured athletes, based on clinical signs and in agreement with the 112 AREU Operations Centre.

The injured person will be transported to the most appropriate hospital or by ambulances on duty or, if deemed appropriate, by alerting the regional helicopter rescue service (flight time 20', total time including activation 30').

The available destinations are Sondalo's hospital or the Trauma Centers in Sondrio.

The ambulance at the bottom of the "D. Compagnoni" gondola remain available for the assessment and treatment of "minor injuries" and for the possible hospitalization of injured persons for whom the use of the helicopter is not necessary and/or for injured persons who cannot be transported due to clinical reasons and/or adverse weather conditions.

The medical aid has to be provided to anyone who needs it, even if not belonging to athletes and teams participating in the event.

The "medical meeting" will be held at 9:30 am on 14 December in finish area.

FIELD INTERVENTION & START-STOP PROCEDURE

Each intervention is originated exclusively by the coordination, which will be informed, activated and authorized by the Race Direction. It's critical that the race course is secure and safe before anyone enters the race track. The Jury initiates the "START-STOP" request communicating with the race start and with all the flagging positions. No one is allowed to enter the track if any racer is currently on course.

The 2 sky patrols that after start-stop intervene, possibly accompany the athlete downstream, if minor injured. If needed, Toboggans are available. The medical assistance will be guaranteed by the medical staff present at the bottom. If the athlete doesn't move, or is full of pain, the delegate on the slope will activate the race doctor and as soon as possible (no more than 5 minutes) the nurse will be on target (level2), or in case of emergency (level3), the doctor too.

In case of serious trauma, for which are needed ALS manoeuvres, the coordinating doctor requests the intervention of the AREU helicopter crew by telephone, starting the first stabilization manoeuvres of the patient.

In case of Mass Casualty Incident (involvement of 3 or more injured persons at the same time (athletes or bystanders), the race doctor will promptly communicate the event to the AREU Operations Center, which will assume the management and responsibility for the situation.
