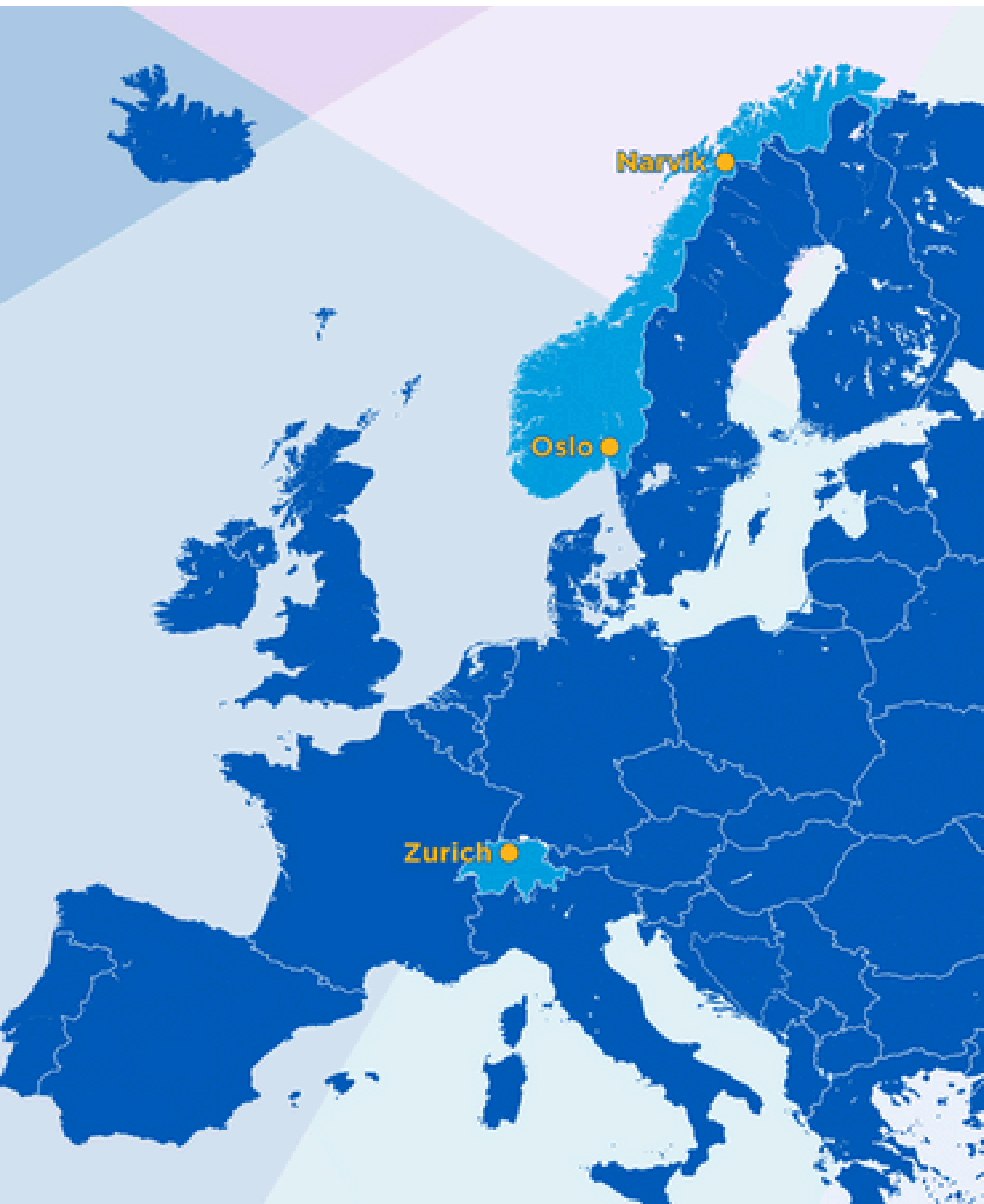

8. ENTRIES

ENTRY RULES AND DATES

Entries by number: 15th December 2025

9.2 The national entry, containing the preliminary number of team members (ladies and men), including competitors and officials, must be in possession of the Organising Committee no later than 15th December of the year preceding the event.

Entry by name: 25th February 2026

9.3 The FIS online registration system must be used to send the entries. The official team entry containing the number of competitors and, if possible, names and dates of birth, as well as the number of officials and service staff and, if possible, including names, must be with the Organising Committee no later than 7 days before the first team captains meeting. The official team entry must consist of the exact date of arrival and approximate dates of departure. The Organisers must be informed at least 7 days before the first team captains meeting of eventual changes to the arrival date and the originally registered size of the team, as well as any withdrawals from the event. If this is not done, the Organising Committee will invoice the costs incurred for cancelled accommodation (per art. 10) to the National Association concerned.

ALERT: There is a huge local festival starting during the period of WJC. Because of this the Organising Committee kindly asks all nations to send final entries as soon as possible.

NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS AND OFFICIALS

Each National Ski Association may participate with a total of 16 competitors, but no more than 10 of the same gender. A maximum of 4 ladies and 4 men may start per event.

A maximum of 20 officials (e.g. 1 team captain, 11 trainers, 6 servicemen, 1 doctor and 1 physiotherapist) may be entered per national team (Men and Ladies):

For a team up to:

- 3 competitors 6 officials
- 4 competitors 8 officials
- 5 competitors 9 officials
- 6 competitors 10 officials
- 7 competitors 13 officials
- 8 competitors 15 officials
- 9 competitors 17 officials
- 10 competitors and more 20 officials

The official service personnel of the ski companies are not included in these quotas.

AGE LIMIT

7.1 Only one age group will be recognised per event. An additional result list will be published for U18. 7.2 Maximum age for entry: see ICR 607.3 (U21 and U18).

9. ACCOMODATIONS, PAYMENTS & MEALS

RULES

- Maximum price of CHF 110 (tourist taxes, full board and lift pass included) per person per day
- This price is valid for competitors and officials
- 50% of this price must be paid on arrival and 50% before departure
- Teams may not arrive more than one day before the first official training
- Allocation of single rooms per team must be made according to the following table:
 - 1 to 4 competitors = 1 single room
 - 5 to 10 competitors = 2 single rooms
 - More than 11 competitors = 3 single rooms

PAYMENTS

We will not accept post-payment via invoice. If you do not have a credit card that has coverage, the entire stay must be prepaid. Payment information:

MEALS

The times of the meals at each hotel will be looked up every day at the hotels, - adapted to the race program and ceremonies.

10. TEMPORARY RADIO FREQUENCIES

Frequencies may not be used in Norway without a licence granted by Nkom.

Operators who are to use frequency resources on a temporary basis must apply for license. When you apply for temporary frequency use, you must provide sufficient technical specifications for the radio equipment to be used, and where and when you need a temporary license must be specified. It is important that the scope (geographical extent and timing) is as limited as possible.

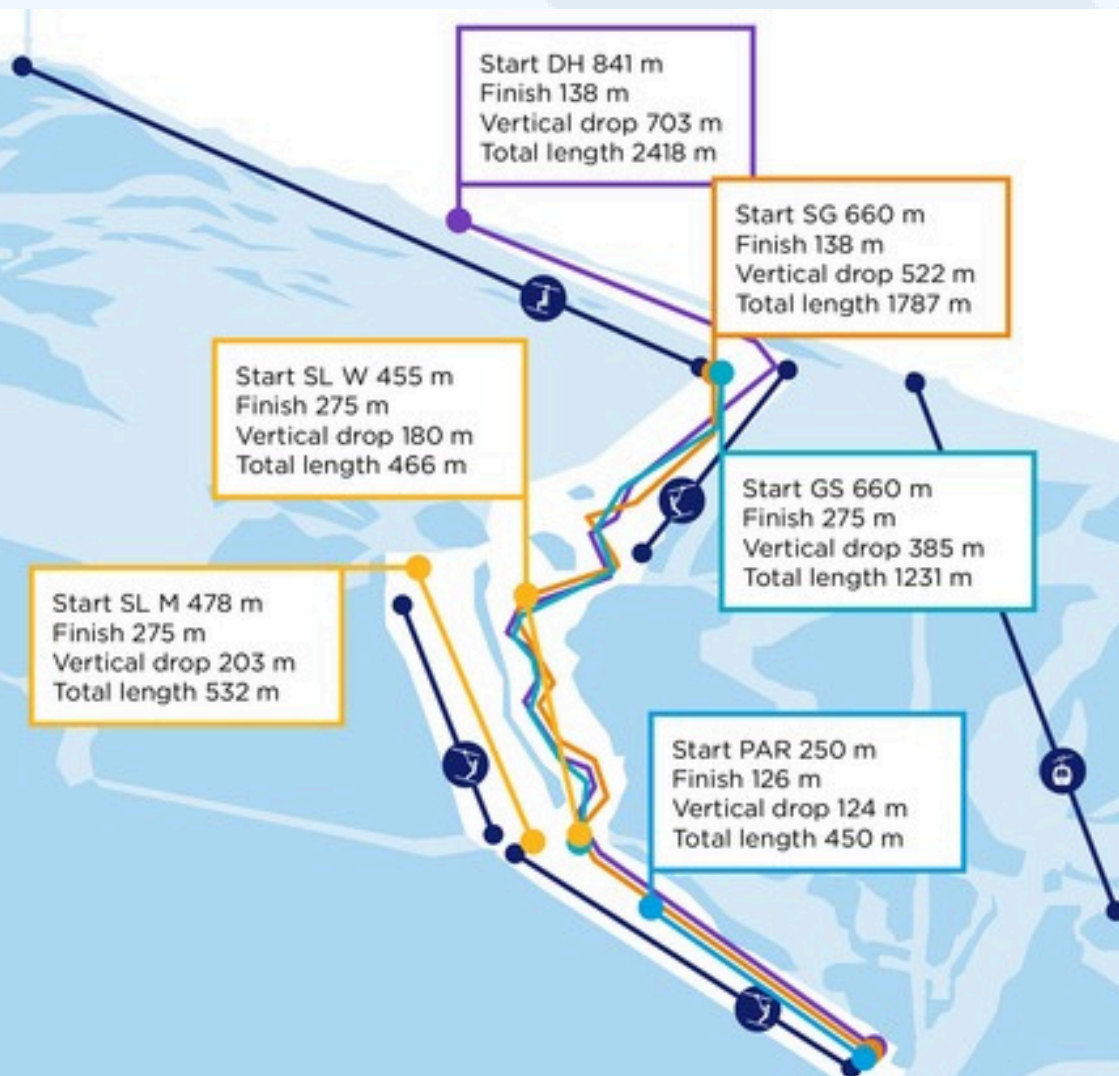

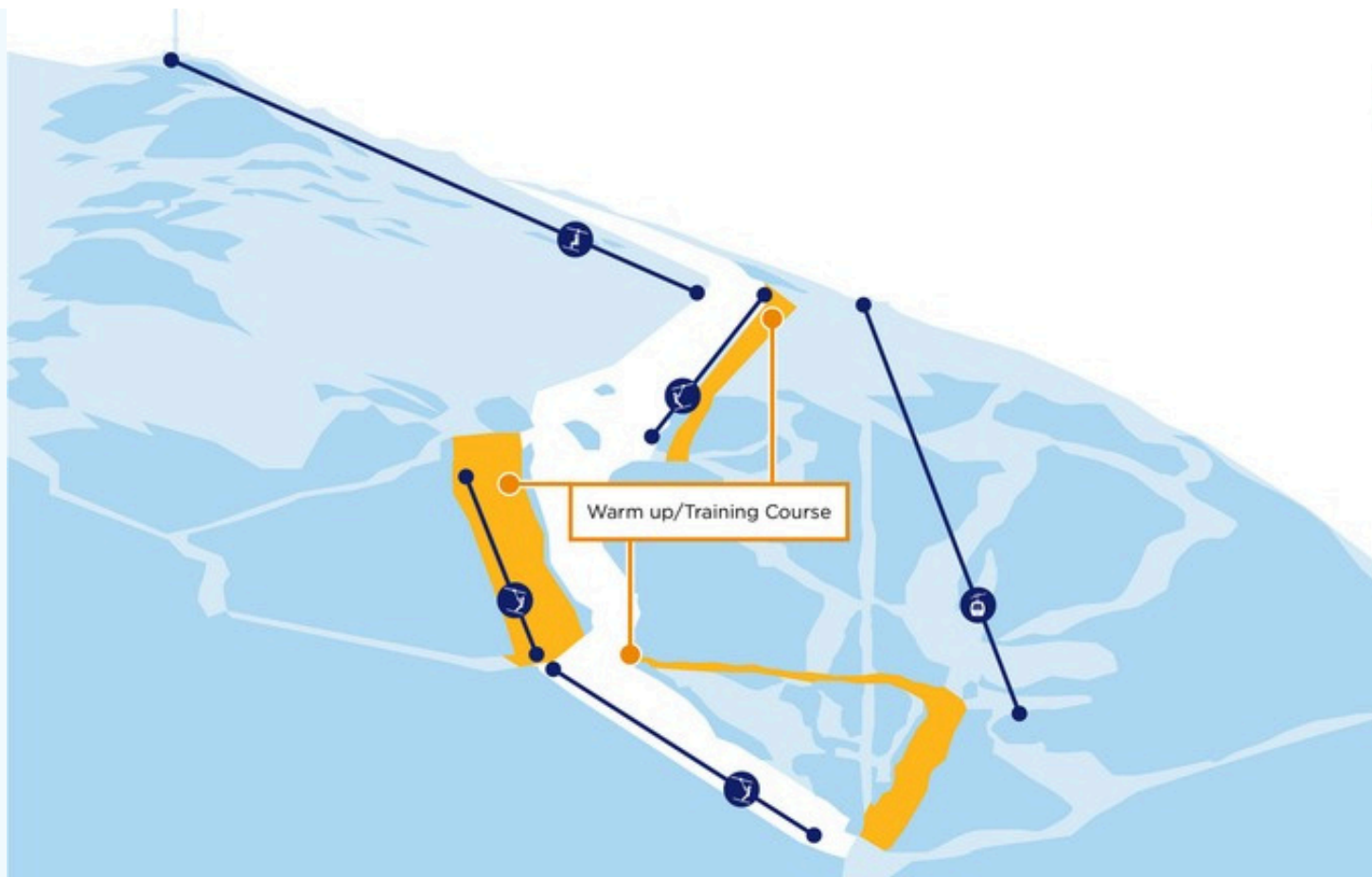
