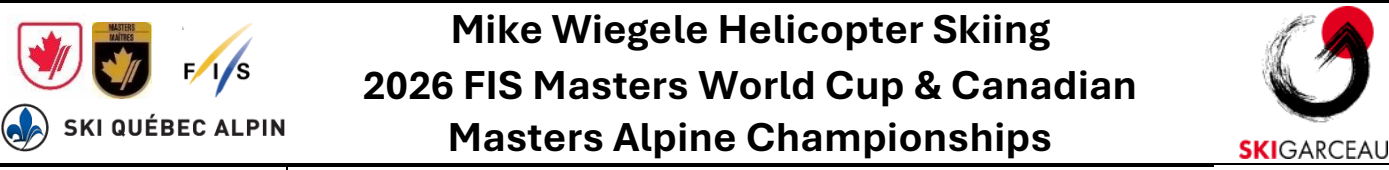

Eligibility:		- FMC competitors must be 30 years or older on 31 December 2025 and must hold an active FIS Master’s FIS code, both for Canadian & international competitors. - CMAC competitors must be 18 years or older on 31 December 2025 & hold an active ACA Master’s National card or USSA Master’s card.			
Bibs:		A single bib will be assigned to each participant & must be worn for the entire event.

Protests:		CAD 160 (CHF 100) fully refundable if the athlete wins the protest as per FIS rules.			
FIS ICR 647.1.3 Right of Appeals Time Limits:		647.1.3.1 Appeals against Jury decisions must be submitted to the Appeals Commission within 48 hours of their announcement. 647.1.3.2 The official results may be appealed to the Council via the FIS Office within 30 days for matters that are outside the competence of the jury.			
Equipment Notes:		A FIS RH2013 compliant helmet is required for all events.			
Awards:		- FIS medals awarded by 5-year age classes and trophies by categories A, B, C & D, for each of the four events (GS1, GS2, SL1 & SL2). - Approximately 45 minutes after the GS2 & SL2 and SL1 awards at 5 pm before the banquet. - CMAC medals for each of the individual races (SG, GS, SL1 & SL2) may be awarded by 5-year age category & gender for non-FIS athletes; the 18-29 age category will be awarded medals for the individual races.			

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	CMAC medals awarded for overall combined of the four events (SG, GS combined, SL1 & SL2), by 5-year age category and gender; plus Champions of Champions.
Canadian Masters' World Cup Points:	Canadian Masters' World Cup Points awarded in 5-year age categories for each of the four events: SG, GS combined, SL1 & SL2. Note: CMAC = Double Points.
