World Cup Information

ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted from National Ski Associations (NSA) following FIS quotas and rules.

Please submit teams' provisional entries, including arrival and departure dates, and accommodation details for all team members (officials, service, coaches, and athletes) by **February 7, 2026. Final entries are due March 9, 2026.**

All entries and updates must be completed using the FIS online registration system at [fis-ski.com](https://www.fis-ski.com) and must comply with Rule 4.2.1. There is no guarantee of reservation or the rate for late entries made after the Final Entry deadline. The NSA will be invoiced the cost of accommodations for any cancellations made after March 7, 2026.

FIS has established nation quotas for World Cup events. NSAs can only enter competitors according to quota limitations found in rule 4.5.2.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

On-site team registration will take place at the Race Registration Desk at Living Stone Golf Resort, 19 Keith Ave. Collingwood **March 17, 2026**, between 9:00 and 18:00. All Teams **MUST** be registered in advance of the First Team Captains' meeting.

One day after the Final Entry deadline, the NSA will receive an invoice based on its team's Final Entries. The invoice will be due for payment before the official arrival day. We strongly encourage payment in advance via bank transfer. Instructions will be provided with the invoice. At check-in, the team will be asked to present proof of payment (receipt or bank transfer confirmation). If a team is unable to pay in advance, an on-site payment option for credit or debit card will be available.

Teams are responsible for extra charges incurred at the hotel, e.g. room service, other hotel amenities, charges for any damage.

ACCOMMODATION & WAX ROOMS

Teams will be provided accommodations and half board (breakfast and dinner) at the **Living Stone Golf Resort**, and or **Living Water Resort** accommodations only, as per the FIS World Cup rules (Rule 4.3) from **Tuesday, March 17, 2026**, to **Sunday, March 22, 2026**. All rates quoted include taxes and transaction fees. If more single rooms are requested, this will be subject to availability and local market rates will apply.

IMPORTANT: In order to properly accommodate all athletes, coaches, officials, etc. we require preliminary entries as soon as possible. Rooms will be allocated according to team entries. **No shows will be charged to NSAs.**

Information on **Team Wax spaces** will be provided at registration.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to and from Craighleith is the responsibility of the individual national teams. All international flights should be scheduled into Toronto Pearson International Airport.
