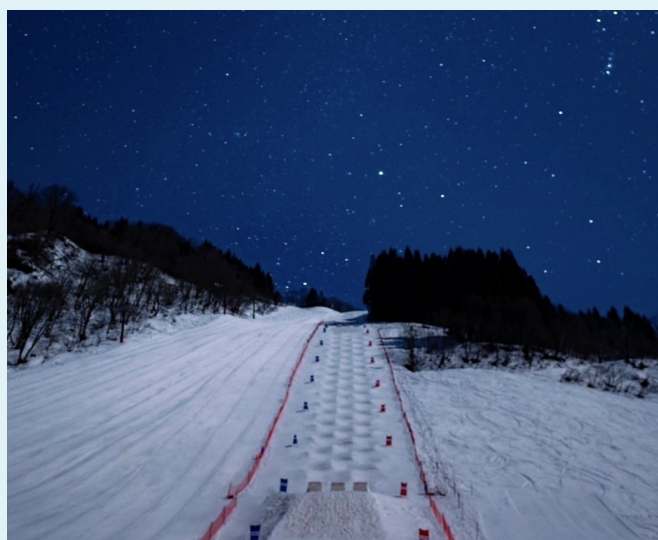
Dear ski friends,

Accommodation

All teams will be accommodated by Hotel Mercure Toyama Tonami, located about midway between the competitions' venue and Toyama city center. Booking will be made by the organizing committee according to the entries. Cancellation fee will be charged according to the FIS rules.

Meals

Breakfast and Dinner will be served at the hotel. Lunch could be taken in the rest house at the competition venue with meals coupons. Meal coupons will be available at the team information counter by Hotel Mercure or at the rest house directly. Details will be informed during the TCM.

Travel Information

LOC will arrange the transportation from Toyama Airport and Toyama Railway Station to team hotel free of charge.

LOC will offer to teams following special transportation:

Luggage transportation from/to Haneda / Narita Airport and Team Accommodation

35 Euro per piece for one way. Price could be adjusted according to the number of luggage.

If you decided to arrange your travel yourself, we recommend to use Shinkansen (Express Train).

Shinkansen is running from 6:30am to 9:00pm between Tokyo to Toyama. Train ticket costs around 13000 yen per person for one way and it takes around 2 hour and 15 minutes from/to Toyama and Tokyo Station.

*If you take Shinkansen, please note that big luggage cannot be carried out.

Shuttle Service for Teams

Between the team accommodation and the competition venue shuttle bus will run according to the time schedule. Time table of shuttle will be posted at the team information desk.

Ski Storage

All athletes, coaches and officials must store their skis and grooming equipment, as well as wax their skis, in the area provided by their respective hotel. Skis may not be allowed in your hotel room.

Payment for accommodation and transportation

Team captains need to pay accommodation, meals and transportation for their own team to the OC. Credit cards could be used. Date, time and place for payment will be announced during TCM.

Prize money

Prize money will be paid according to the WC rules, art. 3.5.1. and will be transferred to the athletes' bank account electronically. NSA is responsible in filling the athletes bank account information to the FIS databases, using the athletes' registration module in the FIS member section.
