GENERAL INFORMATION

On behalf of Corvatsch ski resort and the municipality of Silvaplana, Engadin (Switzerland), we are pleased to invite all teams to attend the Corvatsch Park & Pipe Finals.

The event starts on Monday, March 23rd, 2026 with the first training day and ends on Sunday, March 29th 2026, with the last final competition.

LOCATION

Silvaplana (1815 m) with its ski resort Corvatsch (up to 3303 m) is located in the Engadine, Switzerland. Engadine is a famous valley in the Southern Alps with a long skiing tradition and St. Moritz as its main town. The slopestyle course and the halfpipe are located at 2700 m.a.s.l.

WORLD CUP EVENT/ ENTRIES

Deadline ENTRIES

Entries for all competitions (Freeski & Snowboard, Slopestyle & Halfpipe) will be accepted from National Ski Association according to the FIS quotas and rules. The number of your competition team (including competitors and officials) and the name of participants must be submitted to the Organizing Committee within the following deadlines:

Preliminary Deadline, Slopestyle & Halfpipe:

Freeski & Snowboard: 24.01.2026

Final Deadline, Slopestyle & Halfpipe:

Freeski & Snowboard: 13.03.2026

On both deadlines the names of the athletes must be registered.

The FIS online registration system is accessed through the FIS Homepage www.fis-ski.com (go to «Member Section»).

FIS has established nation quotas for World Cup events. National Freeski & Snowboard Teams can only enter World Cup Competitors according to the maximum number of allowed quotas.

Quotas 2025 – 2026

If field sizes are over the maximum numbers, cuts will be applied according to the FIS World Cup rules.

ARRIVAL & ACCREDITATION

ARRIVAL

Teams are responsible for their own transport. There are several airports in more or less the same distance to Engadine valley: Zurich (CH); Milan (IT); and Innsbruck (AT).

All these airports are 3 to 3.5 hours driving by car to Silvaplana. If you are travelling with public transport, it is preferable to choose Zurich airport (4 hours travel by train).

From Zurich airport you can find the best connection to the final train station St.Moritz on the website [SBB](#). From the train station to your accommodation there is a taxi service in front of the train station as well as a bus service (the timetable is available on the same website by entering the accommodation address).

ONSITE ACCREDITATION & COMPETITION OFFICE

FEES, TICKETS & TCM

ADMINISTRATION FEE

Every competitor has to pay the administration fee upon registration and on site. The payment can be made with credit card or cash (Swiss Francs only).

The administration fee per competitor amounts CHF 80.-

Athletes who attend the Slopestyle World Cup as well as the Halfpipe World Cup still pay CHF 80.-* per athlete.

* Any change to the program does not affect the amount of the participation fee.

LIFT TICKETS

All athletes and coaches will get free lift tickets during the World Cup week, from Monday, March 23rd to Sunday, March 29th 2026.

Teams who would like to ski on Corvatsch during the winter season, before or after the World Cup, are offered reduced prices upon presentation of the official letter from the belonging National Ski Association.

BIBS

All competitors must wear bibs during training, the competition and the awards ceremony.

ANTI DOPING

Anti-doping control may be carried out for this event. Rules and procedures are published in the FIS Anti-Doping Rules and FIS Procedural Guidelines.

All competitors must have their own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers, FIS and Swiss Ski and Snowboard Association decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second or third party claims during the event.
