Important Dates & Notes

*Please be sure to have all preliminary entries in at this time.

- Teams are going to receive invoices on **January 7, 2026**.
- Payment needs to be received by **January 12, 2026**.
- Teams are financially accountable for all changes/drops made after January 7, 2026. Any drops made after this date will be charged back to the teams.
- All teams **MUST** identify a single team leader as the onsite contact when submitting team entry. This person will be responsible for communication to/from the OC prior to and during the event. This is extremely important to facilitate the registration process and accreditation pick-up.
- Additional costs due to early arrival or late departure are the responsibility of the teams.

Medical Plan

The Medical Plan will be reviewed at the first Team Captain's meeting, the LOC will send the Medical Plan to Team Leaders prior to the Team Captain's meeting.

Anti-Doping

Anti-doping control may be conducted for each event and gender.



Prior to Arrival

1. All Team entries must be submitted prior to the deadlines listed above. The team leader is responsible for all communication to / from the OC and submission of all documentation and waivers
2. Submission of completed Event Liability waivers and accreditation requests
3. All teams entering U.S. Customs and Border patrol must have proof of vaccination

At this time, foreign nationals entering the US will be required to present the following for entry:

1. Passport
2. Visa or ESTA

On-Site Accreditation

1. **All Accreditation will be distributed at the following dates & times.**
 - a. Conference Center in the Village on Monday from 4:00 PM - 6:00 PM.
 - b. Freestyle Lounge at the Resort base on Tuesday from 7:30 AM - 9:00 AM

Bibs

The competitors must wear bibs during training, the competition and award ceremonies.

Prize Money

All prize money will be issued following the new FIS prize money process. NSAs must manage all information required for prize money using the FIS Athlete Registration module in the FIS member section. All bank information **MUST** be uploaded to the FIS database prior to Finals. Athletes without the correct bank information uploaded to the FIS system will experience a delay in prize money bank transfer.

The winners will receive prize money via bank transfer only (no checks). In order to process the prize money, all winners must provide valid bank details, identification, and complete appropriate tax documentation (see link below).
