ACCOMMODATIONS

All accommodation details entered in the FIS Online Registration System – Final entry must be completely accurate!

Lodging & meals will be provided at various hotels in the Village of Bad Gastein for rate CHF 80,00. Accommodation for CHF 80,00 are for the dates of the event only. Arrival is not earlier than Sunday 11th, January. Departure day is Saturday 17th January 2026. Early arrivals and late departures are subject to availability and are not available at the rate CHF 80,00. The hotel rates are available upon request.

IMPORTANT: The dates of arrival and departure entered in the FIS Online Registration System have to be **ABSOLUTELY CORRECT!** Otherwise it's not possible for the organizing committee to book the rooms according to plan. In case of early departures or no-show, fee has to be paid anyway.

PARTICIPATION FEE
