Best Ways to Arrive

By Plane

The closest airports are:

- Wrocław–Copernicus Airport (WRO) – approx. 160 km (~2.5–3 hours by car)
- Prague Airport (PRG) – approx. 150 km (~3 hours by car)

From the airports, you can rent a car or use local transport options (see below).

By Car

- From Wrocław: Take A4 → S3 → DK3 → Szklarska Poręba, approx. 2.5–3 hours.
- GPS coordinates: 50.8306° N, 15.5650° E

By Train/Bus

- Train: Nearest station – Jakuszyce
- Bus: Connections available from nearby cities; schedules vary seasonally.

Visa Information

- Poland is part of the Schengen Area.
- Travelers from Schengen countries do not need a visa.
- Visitors from outside the Schengen zone may require a Schengen visa – check with local consulate.

Local Transport

At DCS, transportation to the ski slopes and surrounding areas is available through the venue's Travel Desk. Options include:

Award Ceremony

- Timing and Place: Award ceremonies take place immediately after the races at the DCS finish area or stadium. Exact times are published in the daily schedule.

Media

- Media Arrangements: Accredited media can access designated media zones. Interviews with athletes and teams are coordinated through the FIS Media Team. Photographers and broadcasters need prior accreditation.

Site-Events

- Planned Activities: Depending on the event schedule, DCS may host opening ceremonies, fan engagement activities, or small side-events at the venue. Details are announced on the official event board at DCS.

Training Bibs

- Requirement: All competitors and team staff participating in unofficial and official training sessions must wear FIS training bibs.
