INSURANCE

It is mandatory for all athletes, officials, and team personnel to have valid accident and third-party liability insurance provided by their respective National Ski/Snowboard Federations, covering accidents, transportation, rescue costs, and race-related risks (ICR Articles 204.2, 212.2, 212.3, 212.4, 212.5). The Organizing Committee, Palandöken Ejder3200 Ski Resorts, FIS, and the Turkish Ski Federation do not accept any responsibility for accidents, damages, or lost equipment occurring during training or competition days and are not liable for any claims from third parties. Proof of insurance must be available upon request by FIS, its representatives, or the Organizing Committee

LIABILITY

All athletes, officials, and national ski associations participating in the event will do so at their own responsibility. Once the competition has started, each competitor is considered to have accepted that the race course and safety measures are of an adequate level. The Organizing Committee, Palandöken Ejder3200 Ski Resorts, FIS, the Turkish Ski Federation, race staff, sponsors and suppliers, agents, employees, and volunteers cannot be held responsible for any loss or injury that may occur to any athlete, official, or other individual involved in the organization or conduct of the event.





GENERAL PARTICIPATION INFORMATION

PARTICIPATION FEE

According to the FIS World Cup rules, all competitors are required to pay a participation fee of CHF 30 to the Organizing Committee for each official training, qualification, and competition day. The payment must be made at the race office in cash or by credit card before the competition

REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION

Registration and accreditation will take place starting from the official arrival day at the race office located at the Snowdora Hotel in Palandöken.

TC MEETINGS

All scheduled Team Captains Meetings (TCM) will be held in the meeting room of the Snowdora Hotel in Palandöken. The first TCM is planned to take place on March 3, 2026





TRANSPORTATION

The Organizing Committee will provide free transfer services for participating teams between the airport and hotel, hotel and airport, hotel and gondola, and gondola and hotel from March 3 to March 8, 2026. Team transfers requested before or after these dates will be subject to a fee of CHF 50 per team, while individual transfer requests outside of team arrangements will be charged CHF 30 per person.

Teams are required to provide the following details in their transfer request information forms:

- Number of people
- Arrival and departure dates
- Flight details (flight number, time, and destinations)
- Luggage details (total weight, dimensions, and number of bags, etc.)





ACCOMMODATION

Teams' accommodation will be provided by Palandöken Ejder3200 Ski Resorts at a rate of CHF 80 per person per night (athletes, officials, and staff) (Article 4.3.1). Accommodation will be arranged in hotels that comply with FIS rules (Article 4.3). All beverages except those specified by the Organizing Committee will be subject to an additional charge.

Accommodation payments will be accepted only at the race office, in cash or by credit card; no other payment methods will be accepted.

NSA's must manage all information for the prize money using the FIS athlete registration mode in the FIS member section. All bank information must be uploaded to the FIS database before the finals. There will be a delay in paying athletes whose correct bank information is not uploaded to the FIS system. In order to process the prize fee, all winners must provide valid bank information, identification information and appropriate tax documents in full.
