Entries

Entries will be accepted by National Ski Associations following FIS quotas and rules. The online registration system is accessed on the FIS Homepage <http://www.fis-ski.com> in the Member Section.

All quotas and entries are according to the FIS World Cup Rules 2025/2026. Only those competitors who are entered by National Associations are eligible, and the number of participants is limited under current World Cup quotas.

In accordance with the provisional schedule, here are the key dates for the 2026 event:

- **Provisional team entries deadline** 15.02.2026
- **Final team entries deadline** 17.03.2026
- **Official arrival day** 25.03.2026
- **Official departure day** 30.03.2026

Provisional Entries: Sunday, February 15, 2026

Each National Association must inform the Organizers about the expected total number of team members (Names, FIS Codes and Gender, team officials) arrival and departure dates and rooming needs (competitors, coaches, accompanying persons and service personnel). This needs to be done using the "Competition Online Entry System" and respecting the deadlines fixed and announced by the LOC (40 days before the first competition day).

Confirmation of Final Entries: Sunday, March 17, 2026

No later than 10 days before the competition day, the NSA must inform the LOC of its final entries (Names, FIS Code and Gender) with their arrival and departure dates. The NSA must also inform the LOC about the arrival and departure dates of the team officials.

Please note! For any changes after the final deadline, the Organizing Committee may invoice the costs incurred for cancelled accommodation to the National Ski Association concerned. Teams or people who register after the deadline will not be eligible for FIS rates.

Travel to Dundret Gällivare

Dundret Gällivare is situated above the arctic circle, in the north of the county of Norrbotten, Sweden. Whether you choose a car, train, or flight, traveling to Gällivare is easy and convenient. Gällivare has daily flight connections with Stockholm-Arlanda, and the airport is only 15 minutes from central Gällivare. You will be next to the city center if you arrive by train.

Talk to your accommodation facility or contact Gällivare Tourist Center if you need help with transfers via taxi, airport, or public transport. If you are traveling to Gällivare by car, you can choose between roads E10 or E45. Remember to keep your eyes on the road and watch out for reindeer.

If you fly to Luleå Airport you can go by rental car (E10) or train to Gällivare. Travel distance is approximately 3 hours.

If you fly to Kiruna Airport you can go by rental car (E10) or train to Gällivare. Travel distance is approximately 1,5 hours.

Airport Transfer:

Teams are responsible for their own transportation, but the Organizing Committee provides assistance with arranging bus transfer from Lapland Airport Gällivare, which is the official airport, to the town of Gällivare upon request. Please contact the Organizing Committee by Sunday, March 1, 2026, to make airport transfer arrangements.

Accommodation and meals

To streamline the accommodation payment process and reduce unnecessary fees, we kindly ask all teams to follow the procedure outlined below:

Teams will pay the fee for accommodation including half-board according to the FIS World Cup Rules 2025/2026 from Wednesday March 25th until Monday March 30th.

Athletes, Coaches and Team Officials will be hosted at [Grand Hotel Lapland](#), which is located 10 minutes from Dundret Gällivare by car.

The LOC will charge 80 CHF including all taxes and fees each day. The Top 5 men and women in the World Cup Standings we will waive the FIS rate as per the current world cup standing. All teams shall be provided with 2 single rooms at the FIS rate CHF 80.

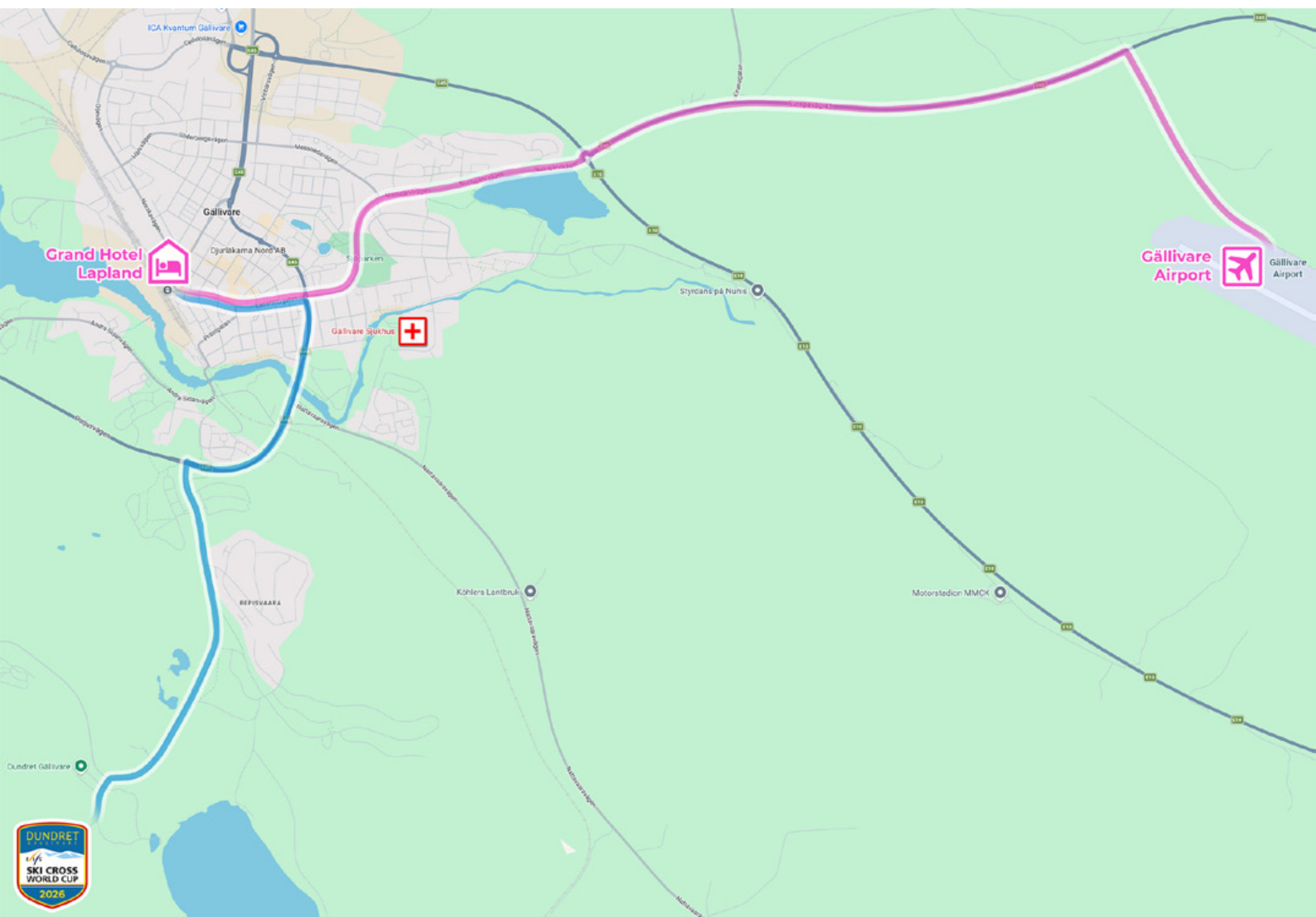
Allocation of additional single rooms per team must be provided at a rate of 120 CHF, including all taxes and fees each day, credit cards and bank fees according to the following table:

- or 4 officials = 1 additional single room
- or 6 officials = 2 additional single rooms

If more single rooms are requested, this will be subject to availability, and local market rates will apply. The half-board package at Grand Hotel Lapland includes breakfast and dinner.

Accreditation

Upon arrival, all teams must collect their accreditation materials and ski pass at Race Office, located at Grand Hotel Lapland. Each competitor, coach, and serviceman must always carry their accreditation badge during the event, as well as their ski pass, to gain access to the competition venues and facilities.

Team Captains Meeting

The Team Captains Meetings will be held daily throughout the event, beginning on Wednesday, March 25, at 20:00, and continuing each evening at 18:00 through Saturday, March 28, at Grand Hotel Lapland, Gällivare. These meetings provide essential updates on schedules, weather conditions, and competition details. Attendance is mandatory for all team representatives.

Ski Waxing Cabins and Glide testing

Ski waxing and storage facilities will be located approximately 350 meters from the race Arena at [Hellner Stadium](#). Teams will be informed on locations of waxing cabins upon arrival. There will be two opportunities for Glide testing, at the start and at Hellner Stadium where the Waxing Cabins are located. If you lose the key, a penalty fee of 50 EUR will be charged.

Parking

Reserved parking spaces are available near the hotel. Further information will be provided at the race office upon arrival. Ski equipment and other materials shall be unloaded in the designated drop-off zone by the chairlift at Dundret. Vehicles shall thereafter be parked at the waxing cabins at Hellner Stadium.

Bibs

All competitors are required to wear their official competition bibs during all training sessions, qualification runs, and races. The bibs will be distributed to the team representatives during the first Team Captains' Meeting and must be worn visibly throughout the event, including during the awards ceremony.

- Athletes must wear the bibs as issued without any modifications.
- It is mandatory to wear bibs in the correct manner (not folded or obscured in any way).
- Any athlete found competing without their bib will be disqualified from the event.

Additionally, all equipment used during the event must comply with FIS regulations for Ski Cross, including skis, helmets and other protective gear. Random checks will be conducted to ensure compliance with these standards.

Regulations

The Organizing Committee will follow all qualifications as outlined in current rules and formula for the FIS Freestyle Ski World Cup Rules 2025/2026 and any precision and/or amendments to these rules.

Insurance and liability

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance. The Organizing Committee sponsors, suppliers, their agents, the FIS and the Swedish National Ski Association do not take any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment during the event. All athletes, officials and members of the National Associations who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The OC, sponsors and suppliers, their agents, employees and volunteers shall not be held responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, team official or other person in conjunction with the Organizing or staging of the event.

Anti-Doping

Anti-Doping testing may be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by FIS.

Fluor ban testing

In accordance with the latest FIS regulations, fluorocarbon-based waxes are prohibited. Fluor Ban Testing will be conducted on the equipment of participating athletes to ensure compliance with this rule.

Regulations of radio equipment/Radio Frequencies

The import, export and the operation of radio equipment in Sweden is regulated by national law. Permits for the use of radio transmission equipment must be requested according to national specifications. Failure to do so may result in legal action.

The LOC will coordinate a single application for permits for the event. Please send us the following information by Sunday, March 15, 2026.

- Name, address, email and contact information for the person responsible.
- Total number of radio stations.
- Requested frequencies, transmitted power, modulation (Analog or digital).
- If you plan to use a base station or relay, you need to provide full information for that station.
- LOC will charge you 30 CHF for the application.
- It will not be possible to apply via LOC later than that date. In that case you need to make your own application. Information and application direct: <https://www.pts.se/en/>

The use of radio devices requires a valid radio license. If none is available, please submit a request for a temporary license with all necessary information 10 days in advance.

Prize Money and Prize Money Taxes

Prize money will be transferred to the athletes' account. A withholding tax will be retained as per Swedish Income Tax Law.

Please note: NSAs must manage all information required for prize money using the FIS Athlete Registration module in the FIS member section. All bank information MUST be uploaded to the FIS database prior to the Finals. Organizing Committee might need to ask about a copy of the athlete's passport due to Swedish laws, the athletes will be contacted by the address they have listed in the FIS Prize money system.
