The event is sanctioned by FIS and Freestyle Canada. Slopestyle and Big Air events will be held in the Highest Level Park on Blackcomb Mountain. This is the final spot in the NorAm Cup Series.

The organizing committee, the PSO, the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association, the resort shall not be responsible for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and belongings and/or second- or third-party claims during the staging of the event. FIELD SIZE

85 total spots per

SLOPESTYLE

- Qualification: Best of 2 runs, heats of 20 - 30
- Finals: Best of 2 runs, around top third of the field (final number decided at TCM) of Qualification results move to final with a minimum of six and maximum of 30.

BIG AIR

- Qualification: Best of 2 runs/jumps
- Finals: Best 2 of 3 jumps, with 2 different directions, around top third of the field (final number decided at TCM) of Qualification results move to final with a minimum of six and maximum of 30.

Men & Women: Number of heats and number of athletes to be decided at the first Team Captains meeting - dependent on registration & final field sizes.

COMPETITION OFFICE

The Competition Office will be conveniently located at the Hilton Whistler Resort, near the base of the Excalibur Gondola in Whistler Village, providing easy access to Blackcomb Mountain (room details to be confirmed). Athlete package pickup will be available on Monday, March 30th from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM. For those unable to pick up their packages during this time, the Competition Office will reopen on Tuesday morning, March 31st at 8:00 AM for pickup.

Packages will include: Bibs, Lift Ticket Vouchers and Welcome Package.

Bibs:

Bib pick up will start Tuesday from 6:00 pm - 8:00 pm. If you arrive later you can pick up during regular competition office hours.

\$20 Cash Deposit Required. ATM Located in Hilton if cash is needed.

Bibs must be returned at bottom of course on Sunday after Event or to the race office, in good condition.

Bibs must be worn properly for all on site training, during competitions and for awards ceremonies.

The first Team Leader Meetings is scheduled for 3:00 PM on Tuesday, March 31st on the Slopestyle Course. All other Team Leader Meetings will be held in the Competition Office immediately following training or competition each day. LIFT TICKETS

We will have competitor and event guest (spectator) discounted lift ticket vouchers available for you. You will need one voucher per day, but you can take multiple vouchers to WB ticket window to purchase all days in advance as required. You will pick up competitor and event guest vouchers at the competition office upon check in. These are not pre-paid. Vouchers are to be taken to ticket window and used to purchase discounted lift tickets.

All athletes, coaches and volunteers are required to register on SnowReg. Coach Tickets MUST be ordered through SnowReg or you won't get tickets.

Competitor Lift Tickets :

Single day tickets during the Event Period will be offered to competitors at the following rates in CDN plus GST: \$89.00 Adult; \$77.00 Teen; \$47.00 Child.

Event Guest (Spectator) Lift Tickets :

Single day tickets during the Event Period will be offered to event guests at the following rates in CDN plus GST: \$127.00 Adult; \$107.00 Teen; \$63.00 Child

Coach Lift Tickets :

Complimentary coach tickets will be issued and available on a strict six (6) athletes to one (1) coach ratio. All other coach tickets must be purchased at the competitor rate as outlined above. [Coaches must register through Snowreg link.](#) Coaches will not get lift tickets if not registered through Snowreg. Coaches please sign up for the Coach What's App Group for this Event - Link will be sent when you register.

Canada West Ski Area Association ("CWSAA"):

All CWSAA passholders who do not have a WB seasons pass yet - must send an e-mail to chris@whistlerblackcombfreestyle.com with your Name, Birthday and CWSAA pass #. When you arrive you must go to Guest Services and they will have your information and will issue you a seasons pass that will expire on April 30th. Please send Chris your info no later than March 15th.

Volunteer Lift Tickets:

Whistler Blackcomb has generously offered a limited number of lift tickets for volunteers that don't have a pass. Please see next page for more information.

Spectator Access:

Both events will take place in the Blackcomb Park on Blackcomb Mountain. There is no walking access to any events. All spectators must have a pass or a lift ticket and ski to the venue to watch the events.
