Sanction Remarks Equipment Control:

During the equipment control, the weight of bib 13-1 was checked. The athlete did not reach the required weight for the ski length of his skis. The measurement was repeated after the scale was checked for level and switched off and on again.

Sanction Remarks Equipment Control:

During the equipment control of bib 2-1, the boot length was checked. It was determined that the allowed tolerance was exceeded by 3 mm. The measurement was repeated, and additionally the boot length was reproduced using a second measuring device. This confirmed the tolerance exceedance clearly, and the measurement result was classified as reliable.
