The BRITS is the British Snowboard & Freeski Championships, staged in the world-class PenkenPark in Mayrhofen, Austria.

A long-established event starting in 1990 and now for the first time in 2026 becoming a sanctioned FIS National Championships providing opportunities for international athletes to acquire points for the new and separate FIS ranking in the disciplines of BIG AIR & STREETSTYLE.

3. Registration

Rider registration will take place at Hotel Strass, Mayrhofen.

4. Bibs

Bibs will be provided by the organization at registration and are mandatory to wear during the competition only. A 20 euro refundable bib deposit payable

5. Ski Pass

Ski Passes can be purchased either online or in resort at Mayrhofen.

6. Accommodation

7. Transportation

Riders are responsible for their own transportation. Mayrhofen has great travel links including a railway service directly into resort. Further details available at www.britssnow.com.

8. Accident Insurance

Each competitor must have his/her own medical insurance.

The Organizing Committee, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, the host resort, the FIS and GB Snowsports decline any responsibility for accidents, damaged or lost equipment and second- and third-party claims during the event.

Ski patrol in conjunction with the Competition Jury will coordinate any necessary medical care or transportation to hospital.

All athletes, officials and members of the National Association who attend and participate in the event shall do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, its employees /volunteers, sponsors, suppliers, their agents, the host resort, the FIS and GB Snowsports, shall not be responsible for any losses or injuries incurred or suffered by any athlete, official or other person in conjunction with the organizing or staging of the event.
