Startgate - Little bowl - Wu-tang with 2 landings - Pyramide - Step up - Table - Step down - Step up jump - Jump - Roller - Jump (Intermediate 1 in take off) - Left negative turn (T1) - Right turn (T2) - Halfpipe - Left turn (T3) - Halfpipe - Right turn (T4) - Double roller (Intermediate 1 in 1st roller) - Left turn (T5) - Step down - Right turn (T6) - Step up jump (Intermediate 2 in take off) - Dragon back with 3 rollers up and 3 rollers down - Jump - Left daytona turn (T7) - Double roller - Baby dragon back with 2 rollers up and 1 roller down (ICR7611.2 line in 1st roller) - Finishline - Exit gate is on the right end of the finish correl
