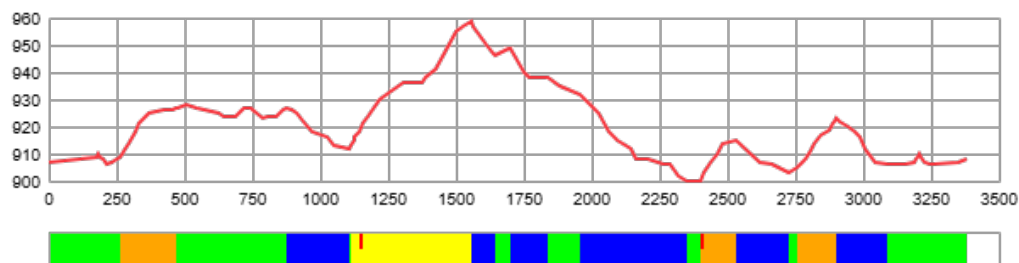


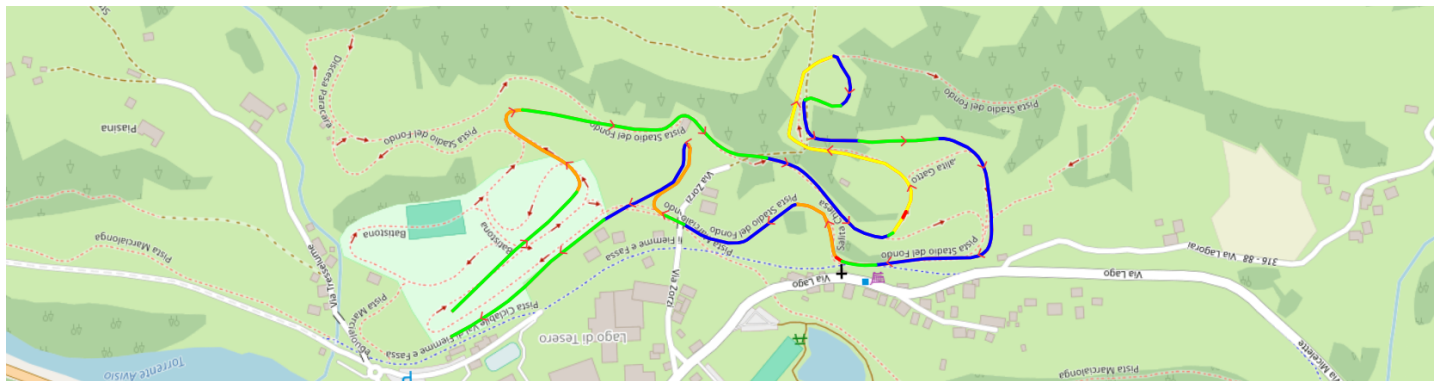

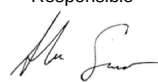

Competitions in February-March requires a lot of artificial snow. The weather conditions can make downhill icy or slushy increasing safety risk. Also flood is possible if draining is not working well.
